## 1. Review of joint activities in 2022

• Participants reviewed the activities of the WG in 2022. And discussed the ER and Comms priorities for 2023.

### 2. Communication Working Group's Priorities for 2023

- The Principal Coordinator updated the participants on the updated coordination structure
  effective from 1 Jan 2023, also the challenging environment in the humanitarian funding for
  this year. The JRP appeal for 2023 is at the level of USD 876M.
- ISCG is working on the new website for the Rohingya Refugee Response operation and coordination structure.
- ISCG plans to organize workshops on priority skill/capacity areas for WG members in 2023. Social Media Messaging/Storytelling and Media Engagement Skills are among the areas being evaluated.
- ISCG ER and Communications WG will also focus on betterment of signages in the camps.
- For issues like signage in camps, social media usage and common messaging around campaigns, WG can set up small task forces.

#### 3. Update on JRP 2023 (ISCG)

ISCG updated members on the progress regarding JRP 2023 and launch plans. UNHCR updated the WG on their plans for the upcoming JRP. An online event in Geneva for 13th February is among the planned activities. ISCG ER and Comms Unit will share the JRP related advocacy and visibility materials (under strict embargo until the launch) with the WG members.

### 4. Update on Donor Missions and Mission SOPs for UN and partners (ISCG/Comms and ER Group)

ISCG will continue feeding members of the WG with suggested content and materials while being in contact with agencies and partners for their new content suggestions.
