Partners are requested to start the rationalization process and the process should be completed by May 2023. It has been discussed that the Case Transfer process should start after the completion of the handover of other activities. The case transfer/handover template needs to be completed by the outgoing agency. All the outgoing agencies need to start working on preparing their case summary in the suggested template. Voice from the field	 Few of the Partners shared that, there are some CM agencies who do not response promptly. Blocks are demarcated by different agencies. But sometimes they do not get a response from responsible CM partners of specific blocks given the excuse that they do not have staff or any way to support a child after working hours. Therefore, few agencies are taking much pressure to support those children. Some agencies are claiming that they are covering many blocks though they do not have enough human resources for that. In such situation agencies should reach out to CPFP as they are coordinating with all the CP actors. Also reach out to CPSS if any agency does not work or response for their areas of responsibility. The Case Management coverage map has not been updated for a long time. It needs to be updated and shared with all partners. SCI SAFE HOME at Teknaf is open now after reconstruction. As the security situation in the camps is not good and this type of incident can happen again, we need to prepare an emergency plan. Many partners are storing their case files at camp which is risky.
