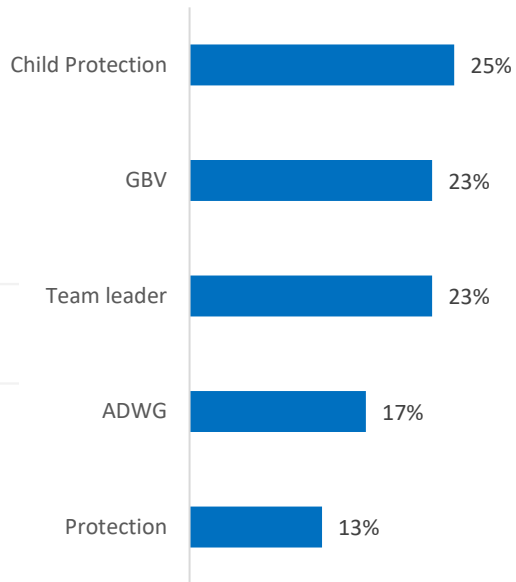

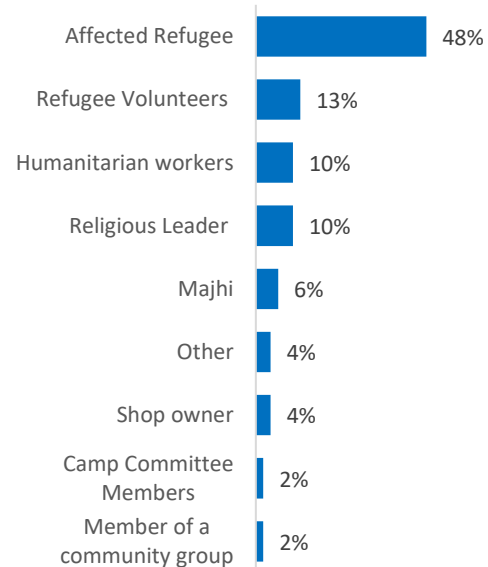

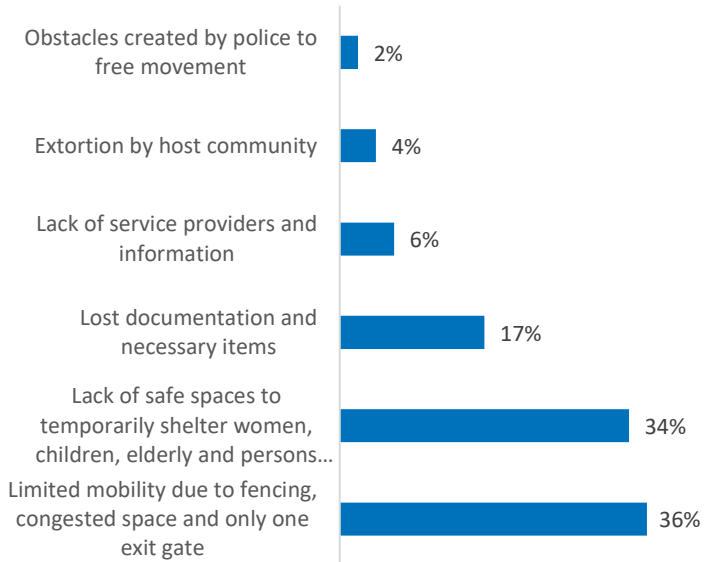

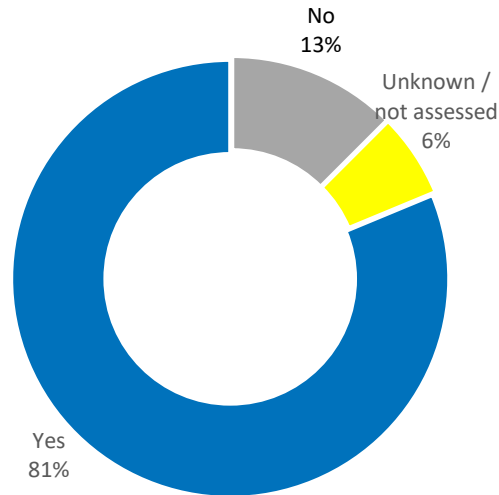

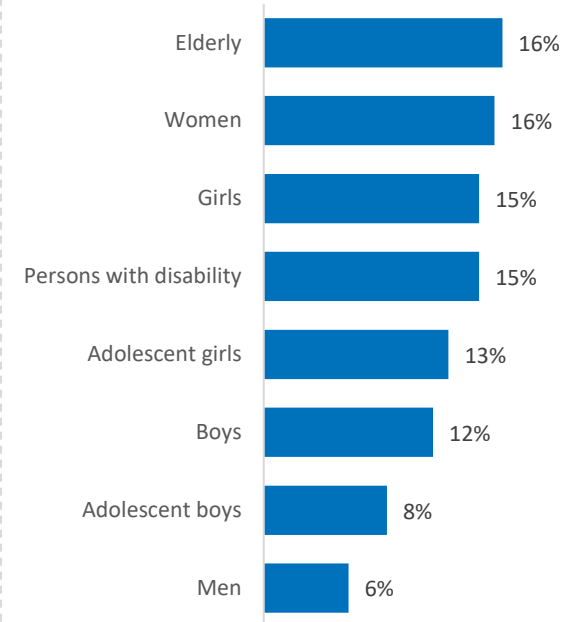
During this emergency, what type of barriers did refugees face in seeking safety (eg. during the evacuation)?



Safety/security concerns during the emergency

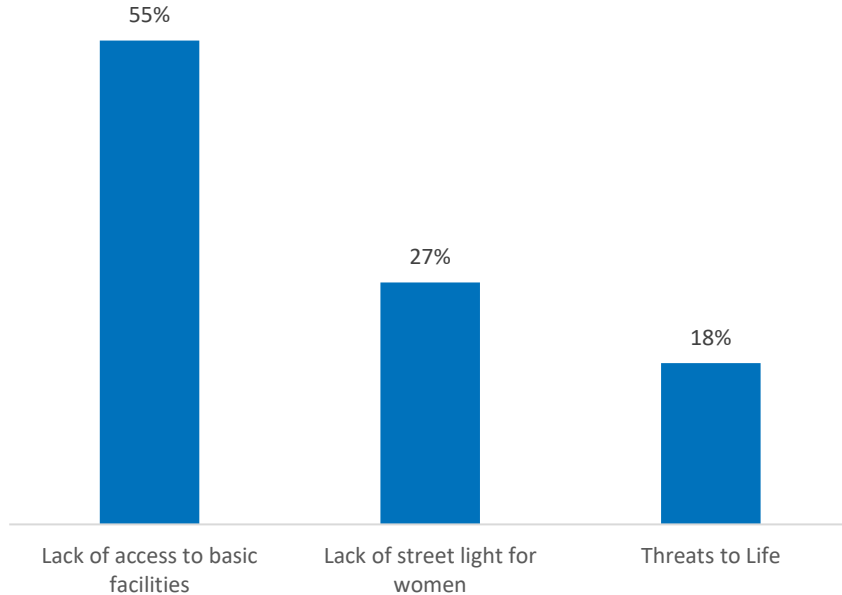


Who in the community is most exposed to the risk?

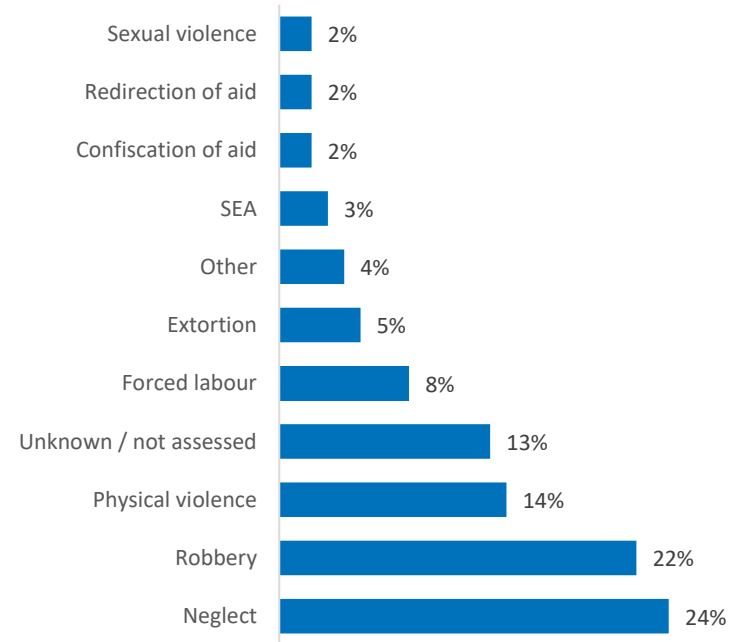

What are the major protection risks as a result of this emergency?

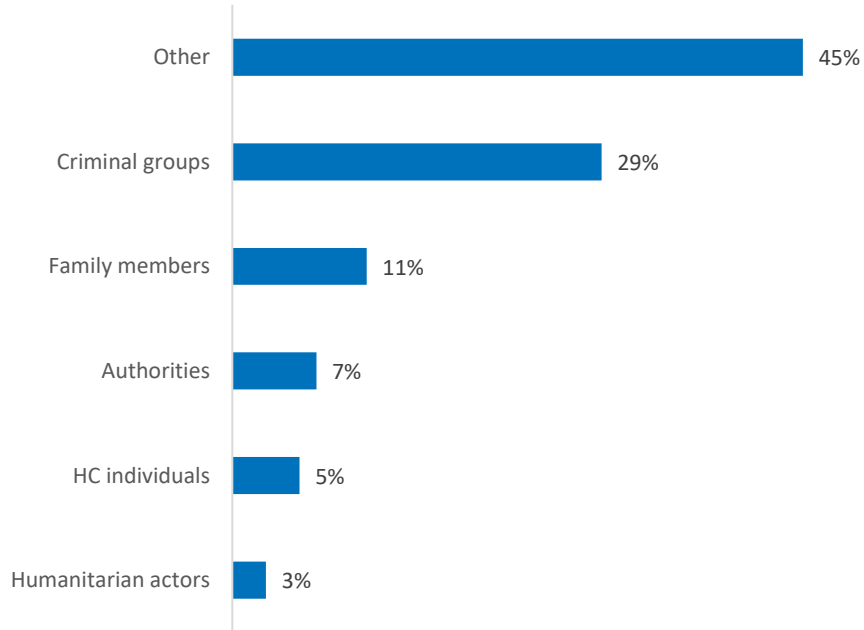


Violence faced by refugees after/because of the emergency

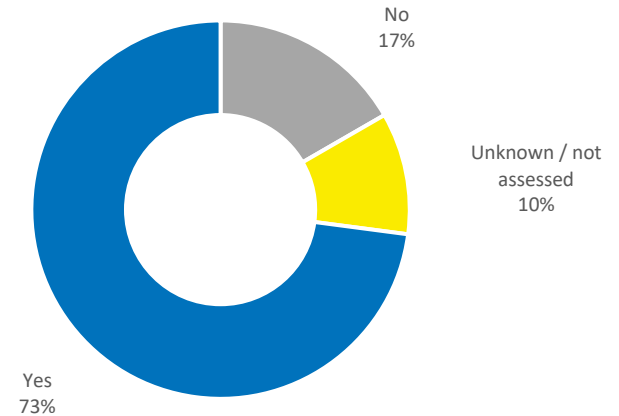

Who is considered to be causing the safety concerns?

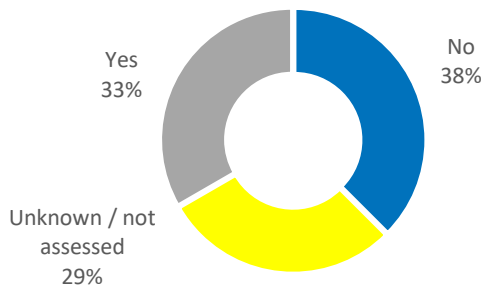


Since the disaster/emergency, have there been cases of families who have been separated from each other in this location?

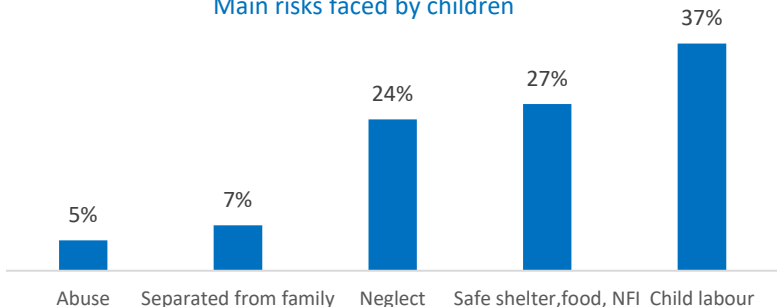

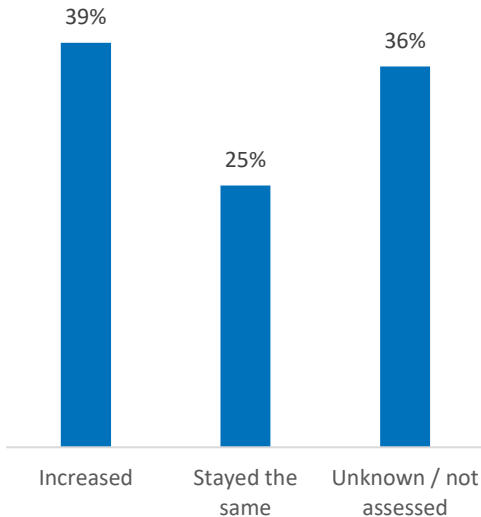
Are there any children in this location without parents/caregivers or who are not living with family members?



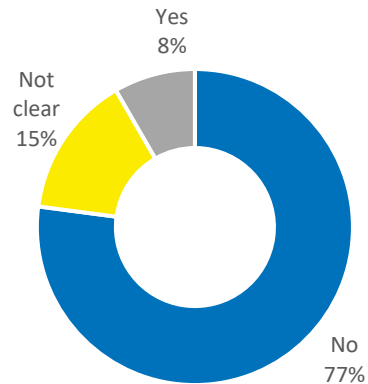
Main risks faced by children



Since the emergency, have you seen a change in the number of children without parents/caregivers or who do not live with family members?

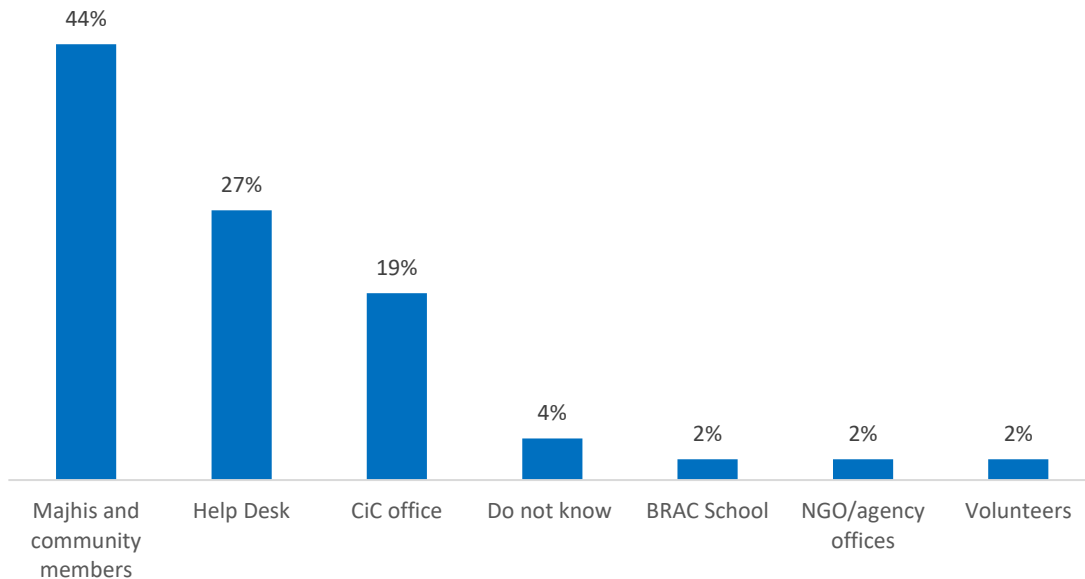


Are there persons unknown to the community who have offered to take children away from this location to provide them with jobs or better care?

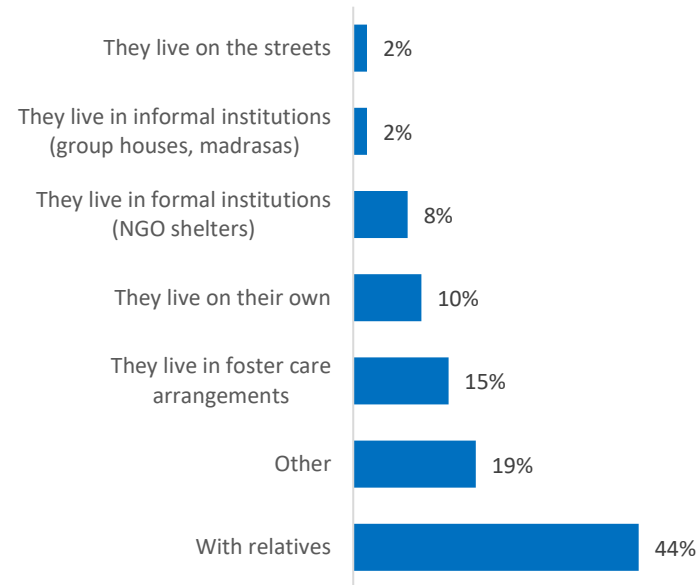

Where do you go for support if there is any child protection concern?

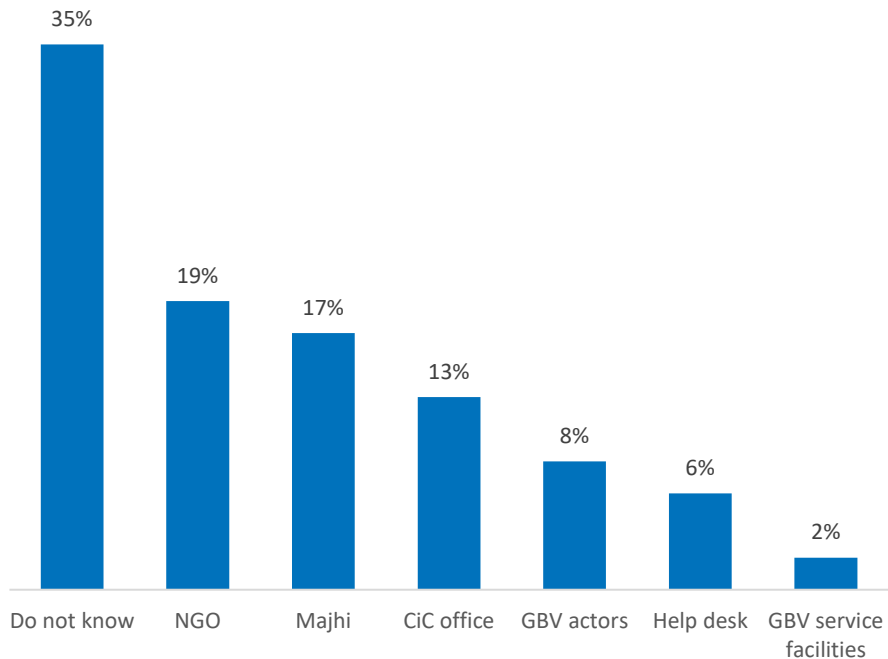


Where do unaccompanied and separated children currently live (sought shelter)?

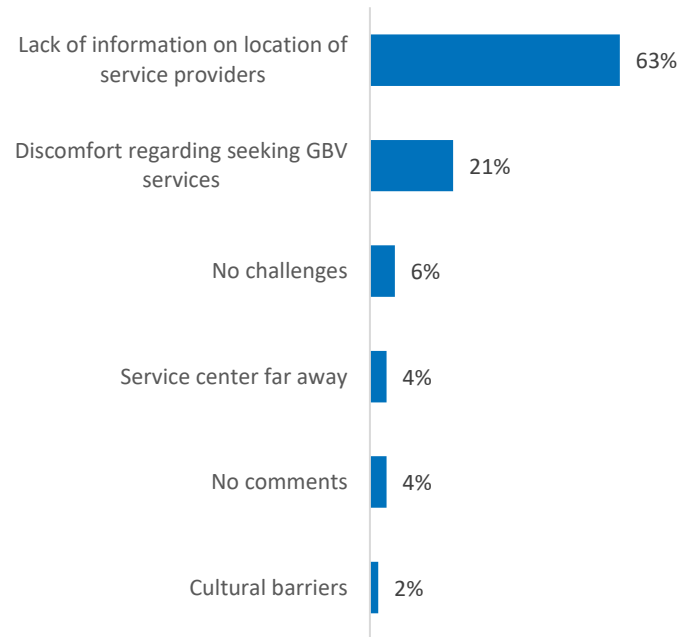

Where do women and girls go to seek case management support?

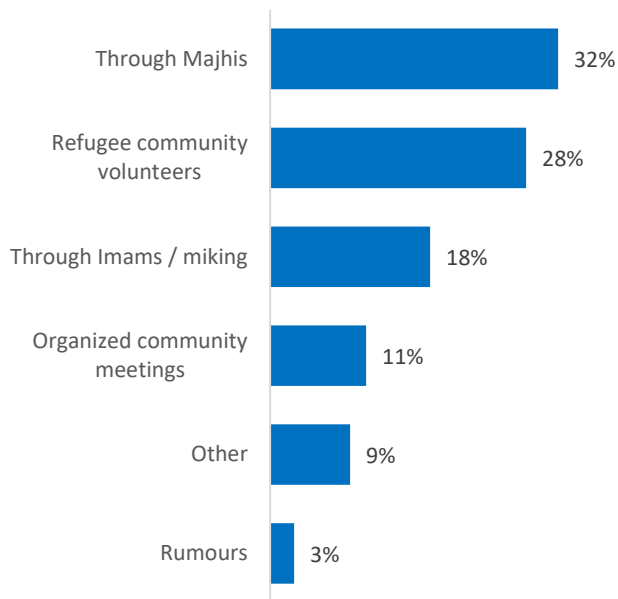


What are the challenges you are facing currently in accessing GBV case management services?

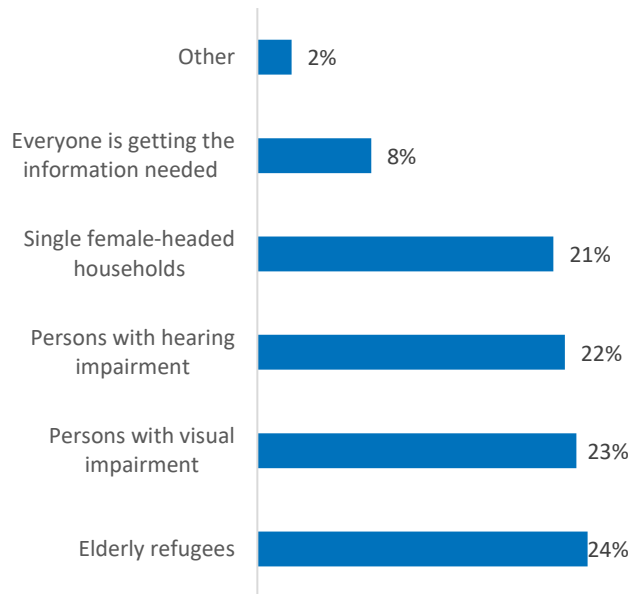

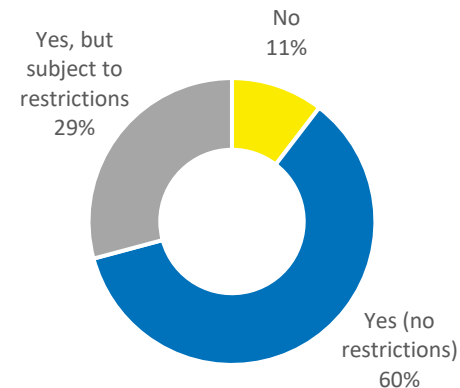
How does information on humanitarian assistance reach the community?



Is there a particular vulnerable category of persons currently not getting information on how to access assistance?

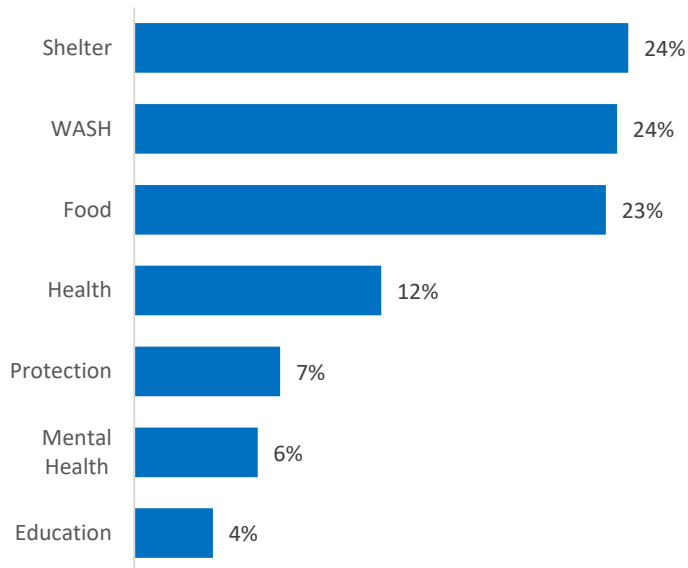


Are refugees able to move freely and safely in and out of the location (within the camp, between blocks), and access services/facilities?

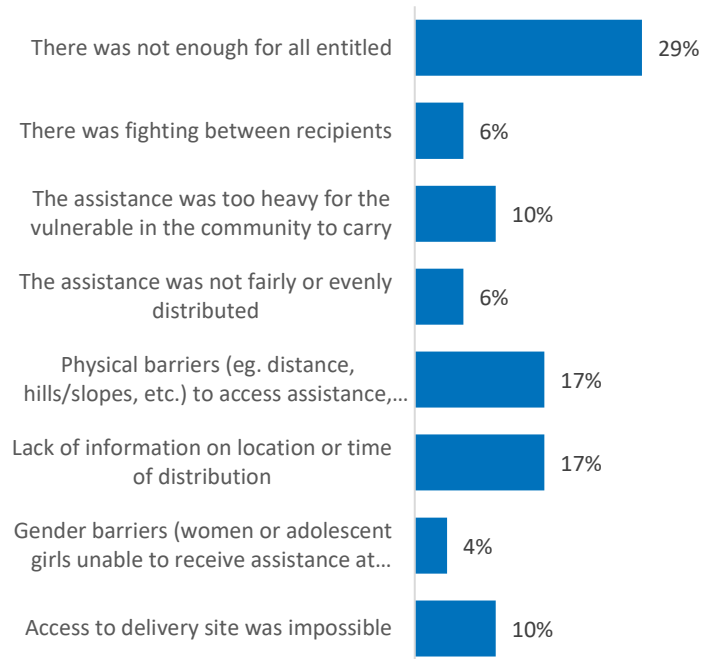

What type of assistance do you need more at this moment?

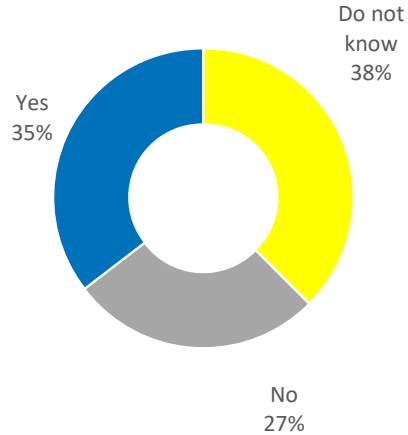


Have there been problems in the delivery of assistance?

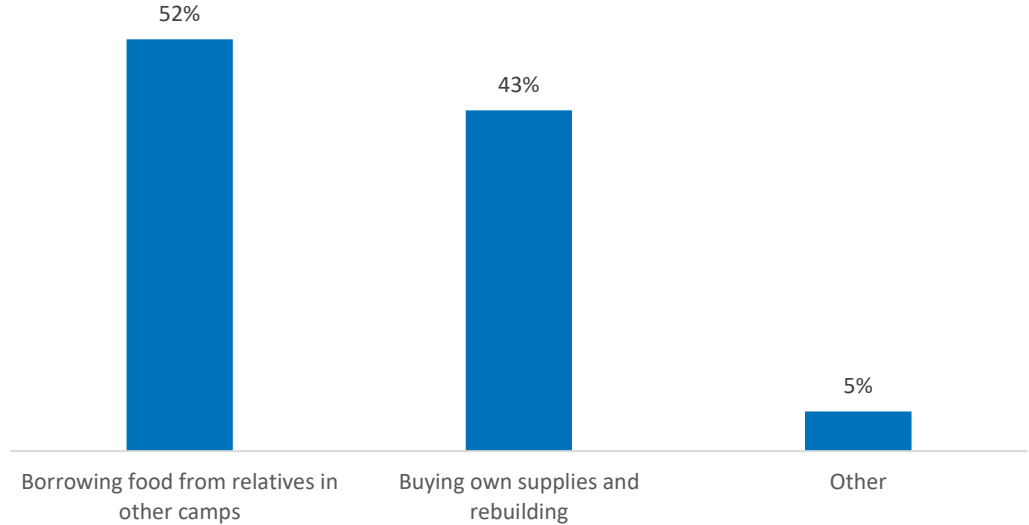

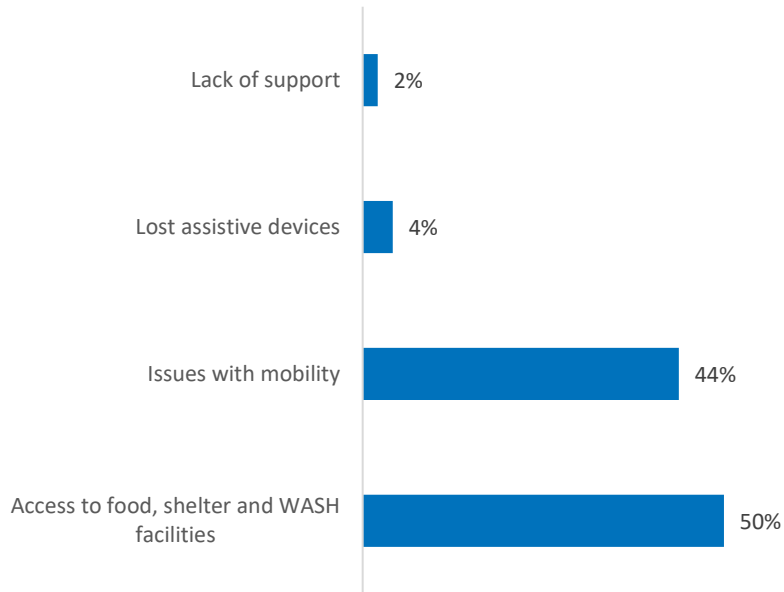


Since the emergency happened, how are refugees coping with immediate needs?

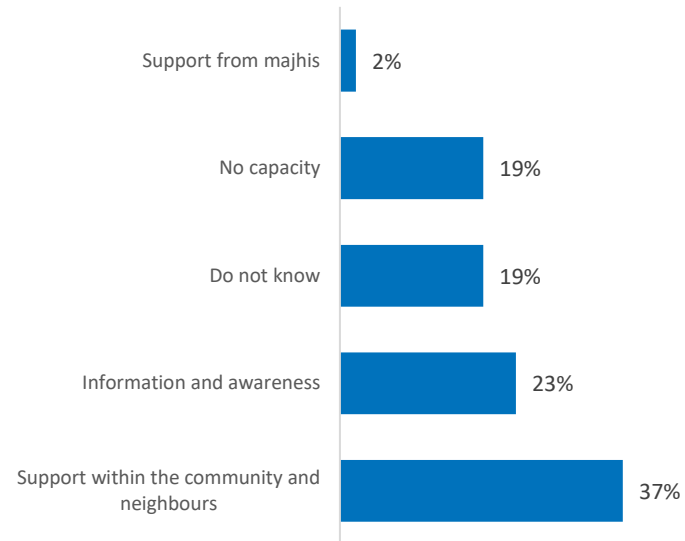

What are the main challenges that Persons with Disabilities are facing since the emergency?

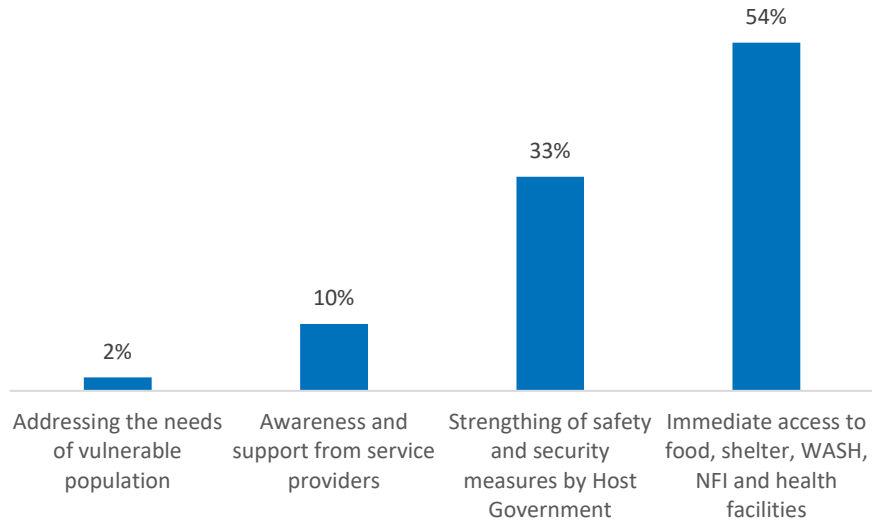


What capacities exist within the community to address the threat or to assist those vulnerable to the threat?

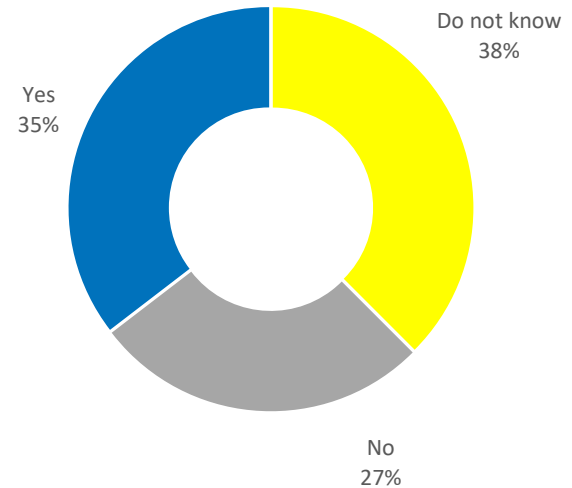

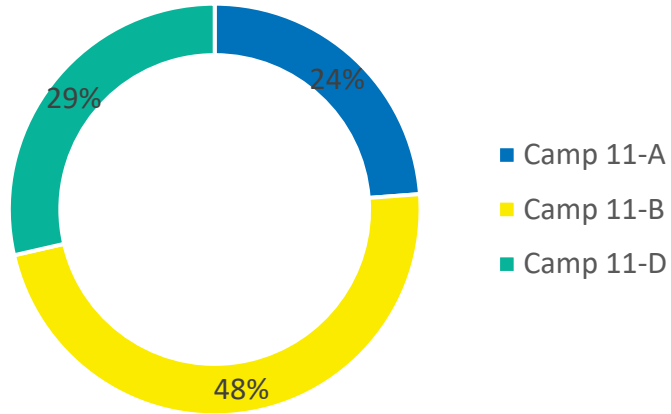

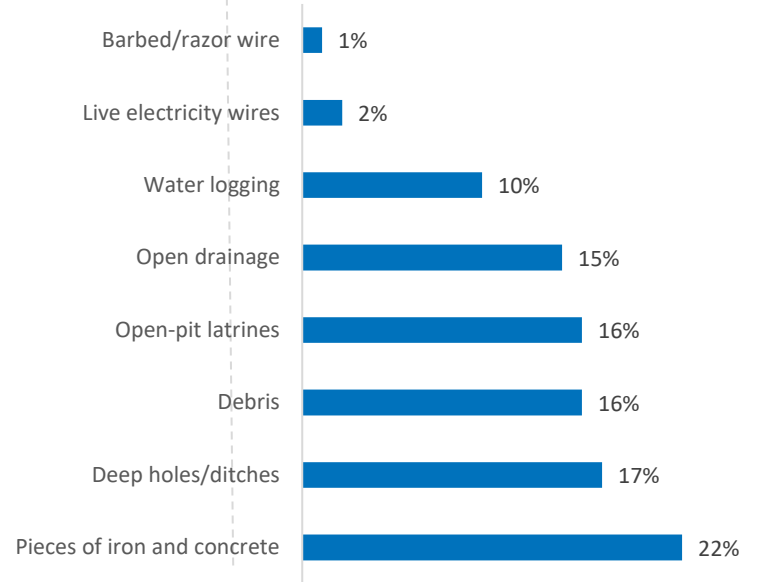
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HAZARDOUS OBJECTS/LOCATIONS AROUND THE AFFECTED SITES AFTER INCIDENT

Presence of hazardous objects/locations by block

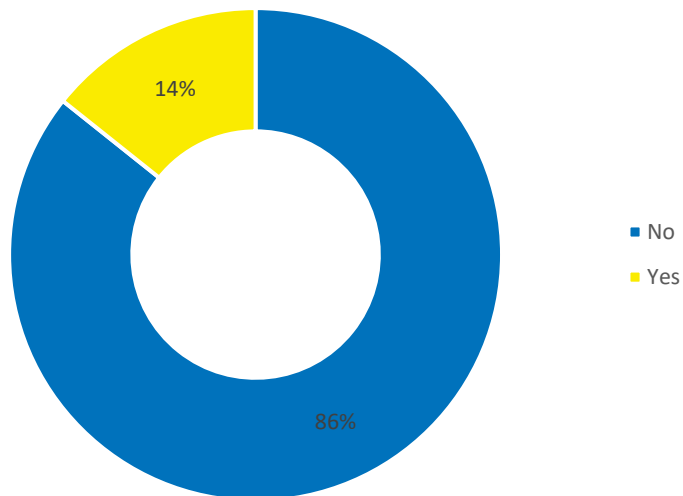


Types of hazardous objects/locations

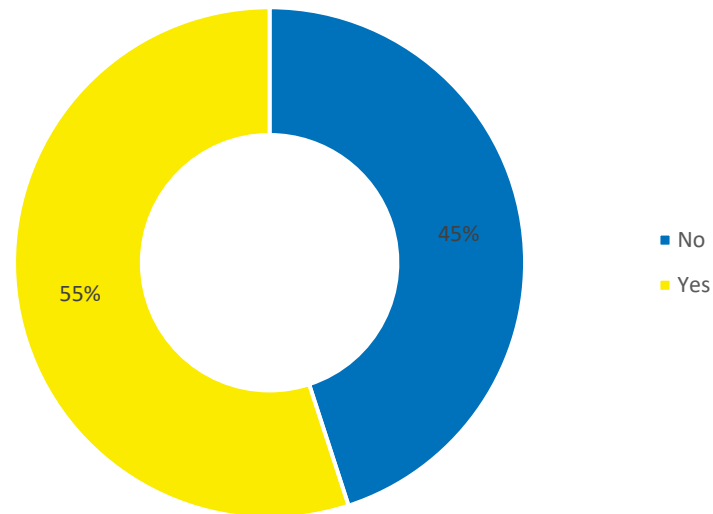

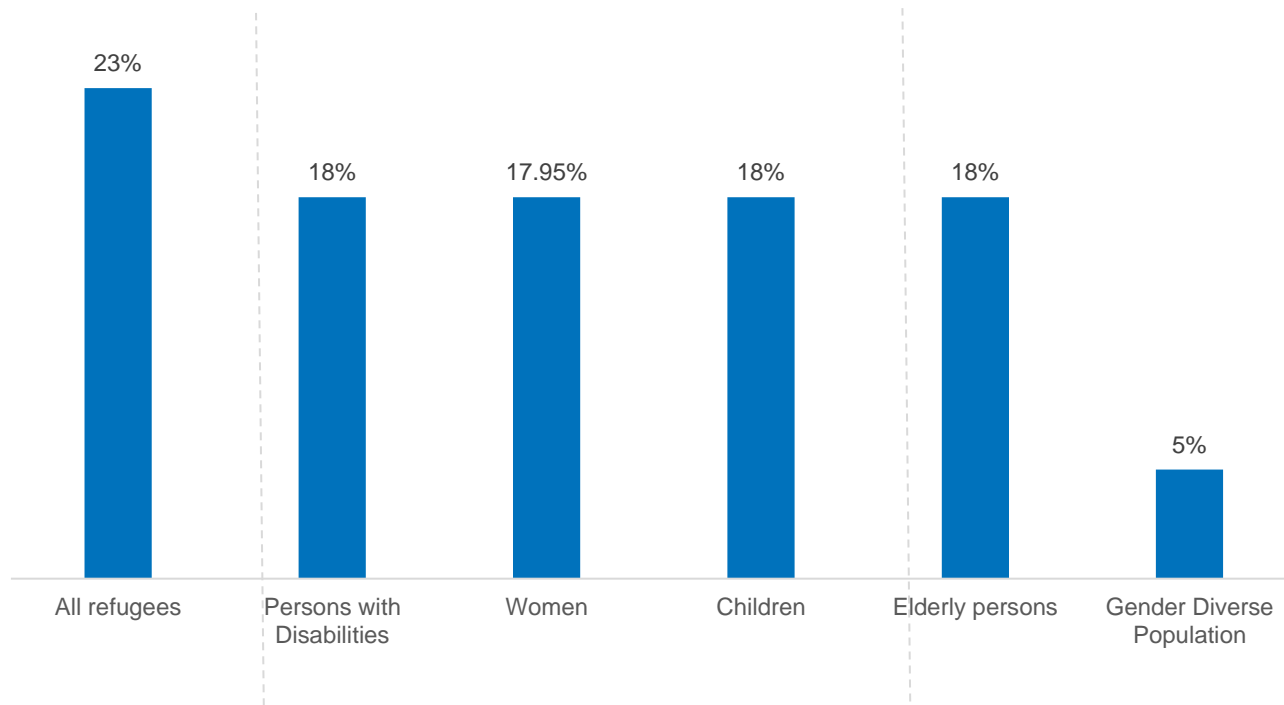

Are there signs that refugees are facing constraints in accessing humanitarian assistance?

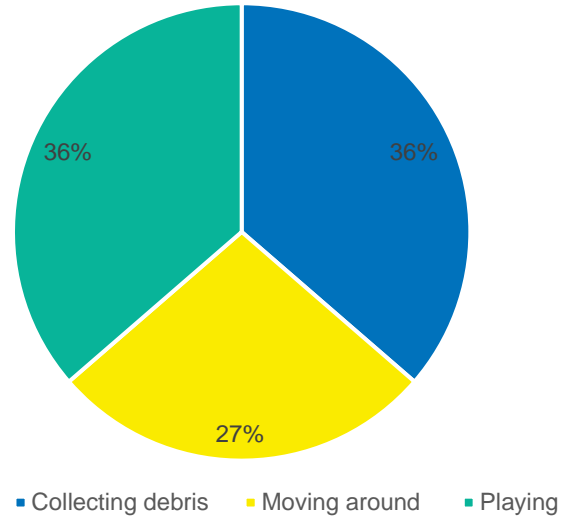

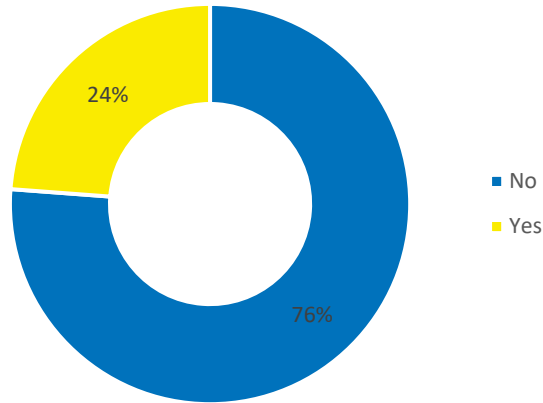

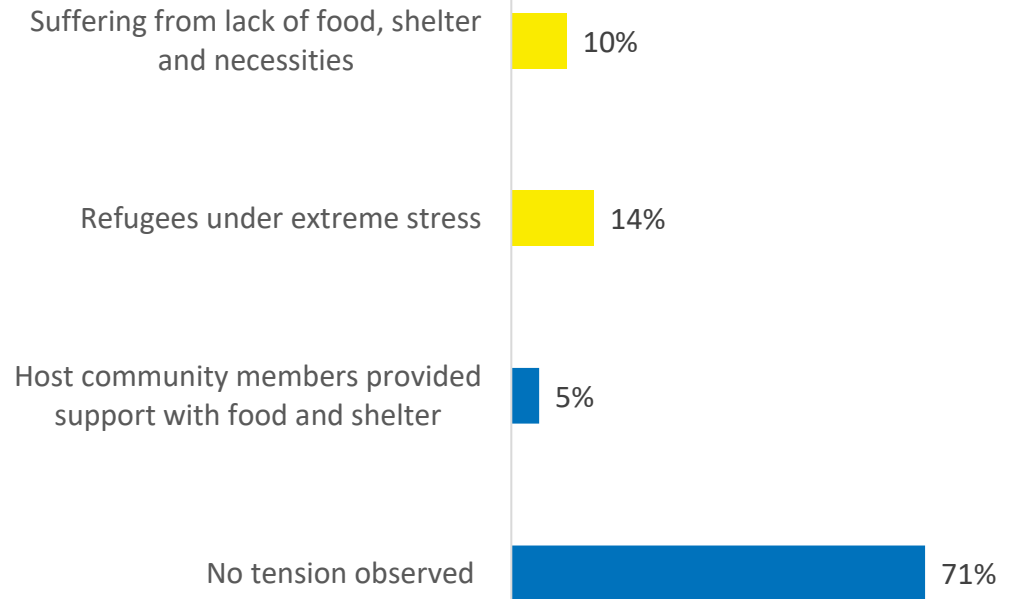

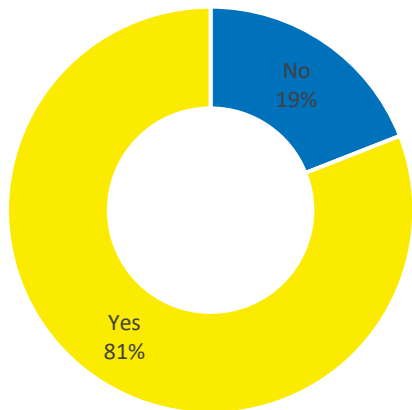

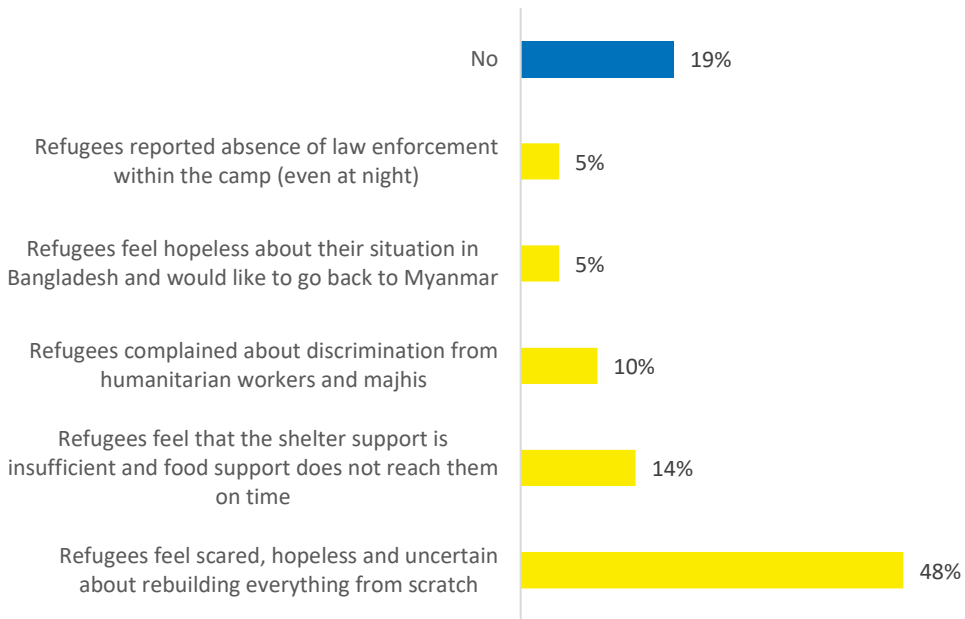


SIGNS OF DISTRESS AMONG REFUGEES

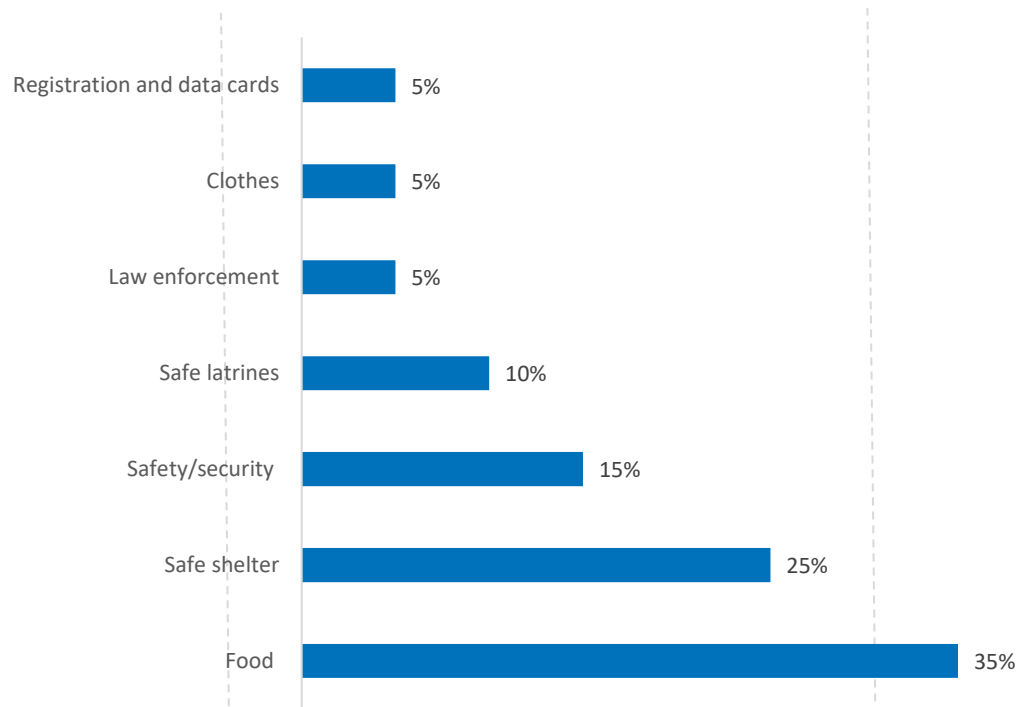
Are there signs of distress among refugees after the incident?
