### **PSEA Network Updates**

### **PSEA Network Co-Chair Selection**

The self-nomination for the PSEA Network Co-Chair for July-December 2023 period was circulated by the PSEA Network in May 2023.

The minimum requirements for the members were:

- Being an active member of the PSEA Network since the beginning of 2022
- Being represented at least by two Focal points.
- Having an operational PSEA Policy in place.
- At least one of the Focal Points has completed the "Saying No to Sexual Misconduct" Training of Trainers.



Humanity and Inclusion (HI) and Terre des Hommes (TDH) were the final two nominees. They shared their Action plans with all the members and after that the Network shared a Polling link<sup>1</sup> to the Focal Points and Alternate Focal Points of the Members. Based on the Members' vote, Humanity and Inclusion (HI) was selected as the Co-Chair for July-December 2023 tenure. HI will support the Network to ensure the implementation of the Action Plan of 2023.

## ToT "Saying No to Sexual Misconduct" on 26-27 July 2023

The PSEA Network Coordinator, Bora Ozbek conducted the ToT on "Saying No to Sexual Misconduct" on 26 and 27 July 2023 at the ISCG conference room, Cox's Bazar, Bangladesh. A total of 22 Participants (14 Female and 8 Male) from 19 different organizations (UN, INGO and LNGO) attended the ToT. The aim was to ensure all Humanitarian Workers are aware of their roles and responsibilities in prevention and response to Sexual Exploitation and Abuse. The PSEA Network shared the training materials with the participants and the participants will share a training action plan with the Network, so that the Network can follow up and support the members. The next ToT will be held on 29 and 30 August 2023. The August batch has already been finalized and the Network will circulate a mail to the members for the September/October 2023 batches.

### JMSNA and Upcoming Inter-Agency Survey

- The Network shared that PSEA related questions have been included in the JMSNA (Joint Multi-Sector Needs Assessment). The JMSNA will be rolled out in August 2023.
- The Network also updated the members on the upcoming Inter-Agency survey on PSEA and AAP. The survey will be conducted in all 33 camps. The Survey report will be shared with the members.

#### PSEA SOP

The PSEA Network addressed all the feedback received from different stakeholders and Bora Ozbek, the PSEA Network Coordinator will present the SOP in the next SEG (Strategic Executive Group) meeting. After the finalization, the SOP will be shared with all the members. The Network will also provide special orientation on the SOP to the PSEA Focal Points. The new SOP will cover all the Humanitarian Workers including the Volunteers.

#### Field Visit

On 17 July 2023, the PSEA Network Coordinator and the PSEA Associate visited 4 camps (1E, 2W, 9 and 20 Extension) in Ukhiya that were covered by the NPM survey to understand how effectively the "Site Management" has been working to receive and refer the SEA incidents. The PSEA Network observed the good practices and discussed with the staff members of the Site management on the gaps and challenges. The visit noted that the Network needs to work on Child Friendly PSEA IEC materials and Community people awareness. The Site Management requested training on SOP, Feedback closing and requested the Network to conduct field tests before distributing any IEC materials for the community people.

## **PSEA Reporting Template**

The Bi-Annual Reporting template (January to August 2023) was presented to the Members. The Template has 5 Sections: A. Basic Information, B. Staff Information, C. PSEA Training (Prevention), D. Complaint Feedback Mechanism (Safe and Accessible Reporting), E. Others.

This reporting template will collect only relevant information to ensure the achievement of our collaborative activities. This template will help the Members to map the gaps, needs and way forwards. One of the objectives of this reporting template is to map the existing complaint feedback mechanisms. All of us need to ensure that the channels are available to individuals with disabilities, older persons, children, gender diverse population. At the same time, we need to ensure that 100% of the affected population have access to at least one safe and accessible channel to report SEA incidents and they reach with awareness-raising materials or session. Colleagues from BANDHU, IOM, LAW, UNESCO, UNHCR, and UNICEF provided their kind feedback on the template. The Network will address all the relevant feedback from the Members and share the revised template with the Members.

# **Preliminary Findings from the NPM Survey**

CFM survey (PSEA: Awareness of Reporting Mechanisms for Sensitive Issues in the Rohingya Camps) is jointly conducted by IOM Needs and Population Monitoring (NPM) and PSEA Network. The survey is held to access the overall CFM standards including safety, confidentiality, transparency, and accessibility of the existing CFMs. The sample size for each survey is approximately 600/700 respondents. Until now, the NPM and the PSEA Network conducted 3 surveys. The first one was conducted from December 2021 to January 2022, the second was from August 2022 to September 2022, and the latest one was conducted in June 2023. This survey occurs every six months. The first two survey reports have been published (available on the Webpage) and the third one will be published in August/September 2023. The Network Shared the preliminary findings from the latest survey with the members.

# Update from LAW (Legal Action Worldwide)

Legal Action Worldwide (LAW) introduced a handbook which is designed to provide comprehensive guidance and information on International Justice mechanism for the humanitarian actors working with Rohingya community. It breaks down the key developments so far in the ongoing international justice mechanisms focusing on crimes against the Rohingya since 2010, encompassing key messages, themes, and practical tools to support humanitarian workers in Cox's Bazar and activists in our region engaged in advocacy for the rights of the Rohingya community.
