

Funding received

The **2022 Joint Response Plan** for the Rohingya refugee response is **64 percent** funded as of 31 December, with **USD 562 million received** against the overall prioritized appeal of **USD 881 million**.

Since the onset of the crisis in August 2017, donors have generously contributed nearly USD 3.6 billion to successive JRPs, amounting to 69 percent of the total financial requirements (as of 31 December 2022).




