Discussion on upcoming EPR priorities Work Plan	<ul> <li>The below priorities with deadlines were made by EPR focal persons and shown in the meeting:</li> <li>Revision of MHRP – gather all comments from the members and are now subject to revision which will be finished by next month November 2023.</li> <li>Preparedness and mitigation activities – are ongoing according to the agency's plan.</li> <li>Strengthening the coordination (with sectors, cross-cutting issues, and capacity building) – all sectoral activity details will be collected and streamline EPR as a cross-cutting issue.</li> <li>SOP of intervention/coordination mechanism or Instant Commanding System (ICS) – finalized when MHRP revision will be done.</li> <li>Update Contingency Plan – will check with sectors and update by December 2023.</li> <li>Revision of Contingency Stock – it's a regular process and will be update as per the requirements.</li> <li>Update ToR of the EPRWG – will be updated by October then share it with EPR members for their revision.</li> <li>Update the EPRWG participant list (front liners) – will make a Google email group and add all potential members upon consensus of the ISCG deputy coordinator.</li> <li>Need Assessment – MSNA has been done and will be shared with the EPRWG members so that they can see whether EPR issues were reflected or not.</li> <li>Multi-Hazard Handbook – will be finalized drafting by 31 October by the IFRC and BBC action media, ISCG will share for EPRWG members final confirmation.</li> <li>Training modules – is required and ISCG will ask for activity details from sectors and collect relevant materials from all.
