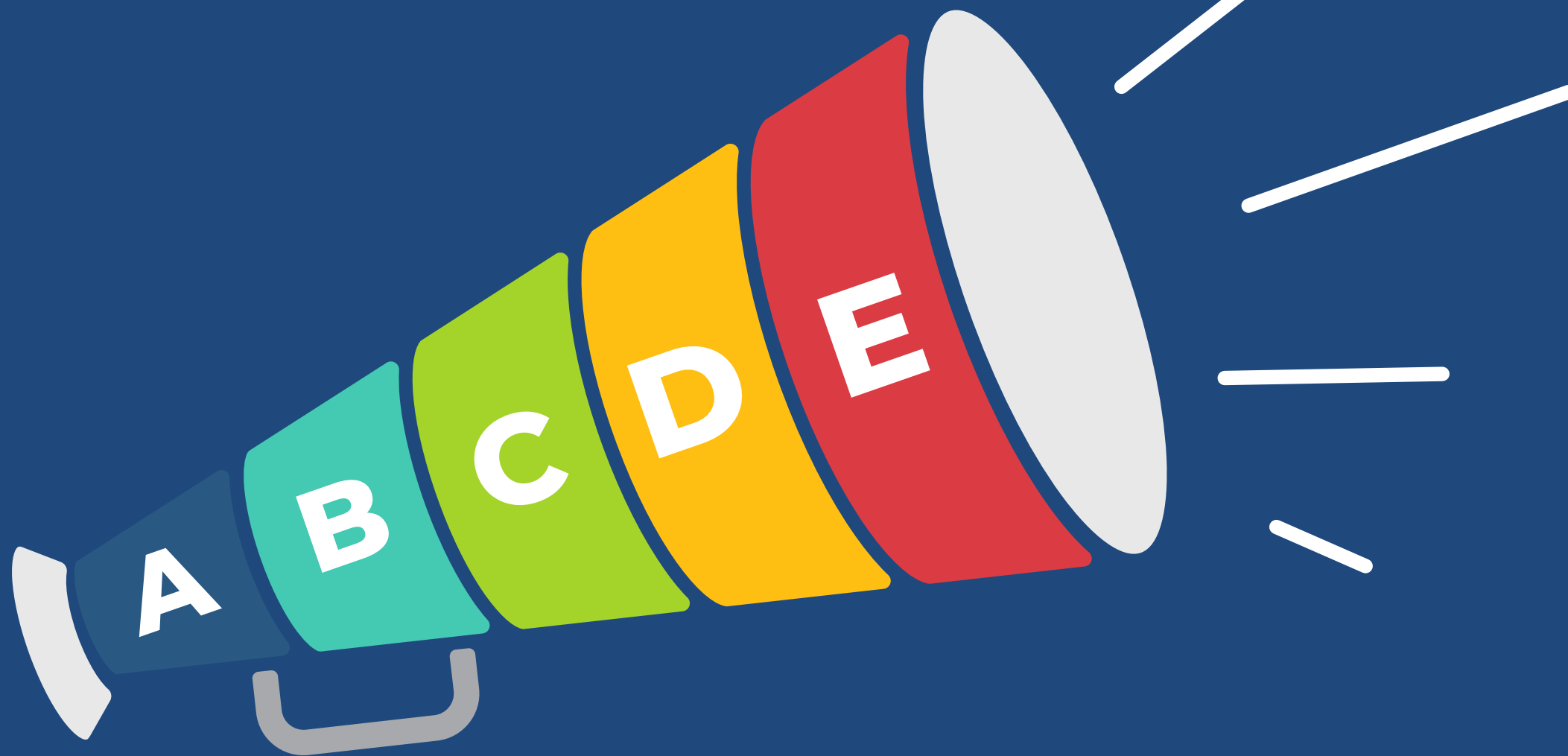

- Use 4:3 aspect ratio/ 1024 x 768 pixels.
- Make sure the subject is well-captured in the photo.
- Send attachment of the photo to keep resolution.
- Ensure beneficiary's consent in the photo.
- Share multiple options for choice.
- Include photo credit and a brief caption.

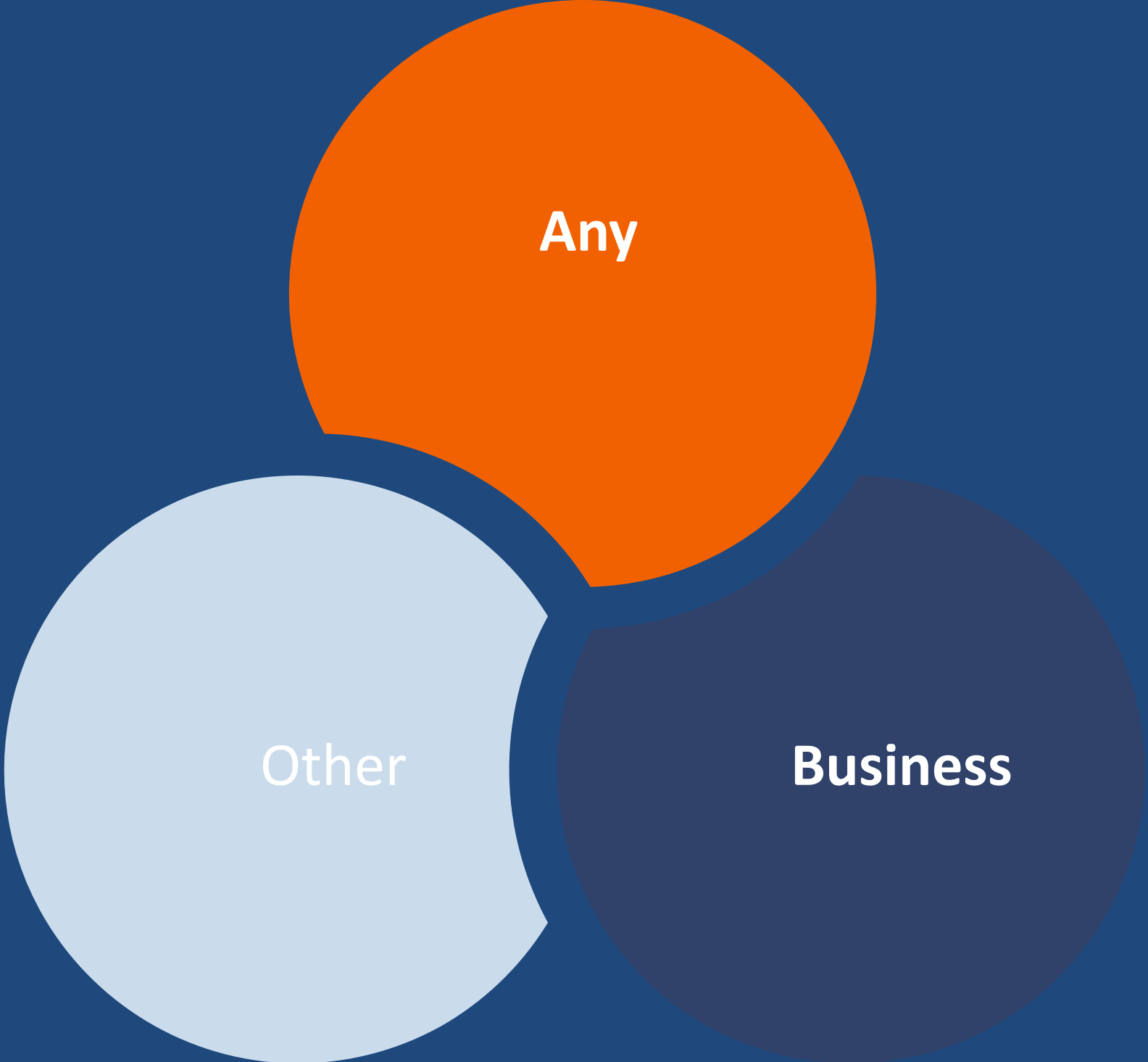
Challenges
