Review last meeting minutes	In 2023, AIMTWG has prioritized the following surveys so far:  Follow-up SMART Survey in Ukhiya and Teknaf (Host).  Standardized Expanded Nutrition Survey (SENS) in the refugee camp (1 survey).  Anemia Causal Analysis (Refugee).  Bottleneck Analysis.  The SENS survey is scheduled to take place in September-October 2023. However, in order to address issues related to trend analysis and comparison between new and old refugees, as well as to consider the interests of different donors and internal obligations, further discussions with the UN agency are required.  For the follow-up SMART survey, AIMTWG is seeking support from the Nutrition Sector to advocate for funding from the UN and other donors. Unfortunately, the latest update from NS members indicates a lack of funding availability for the survey.	<ul> <li>meeting with the UN agency to finalize the modality of the SENS 2023 survey, whether it will involve one survey or three surveys.
