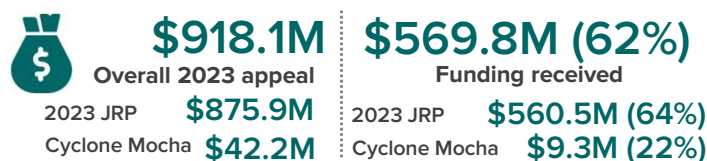

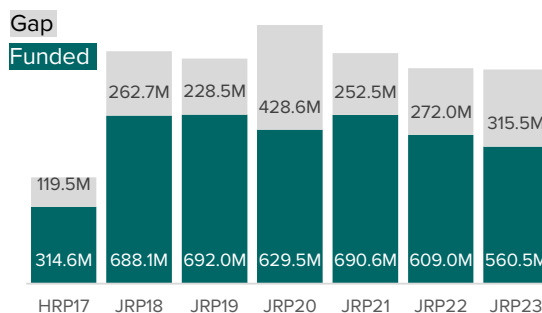
KEY PLANNING FIGURES 2023



The **2023 Joint Response Plan** for the Rohingya refugee response, including the **Cyclone Mocha Appeal**, is **62 percent** funded as of 18 April 2024, with **USD 569.8 million received** against the overall appeal of **USD 918.1 million**.

Since the onset of the crisis in August 2017 until the end of 2023, donors have generously contributed nearly USD 4.2 billion to successive JRPs, amounting to 69 percent of the total financial requirements for that period.

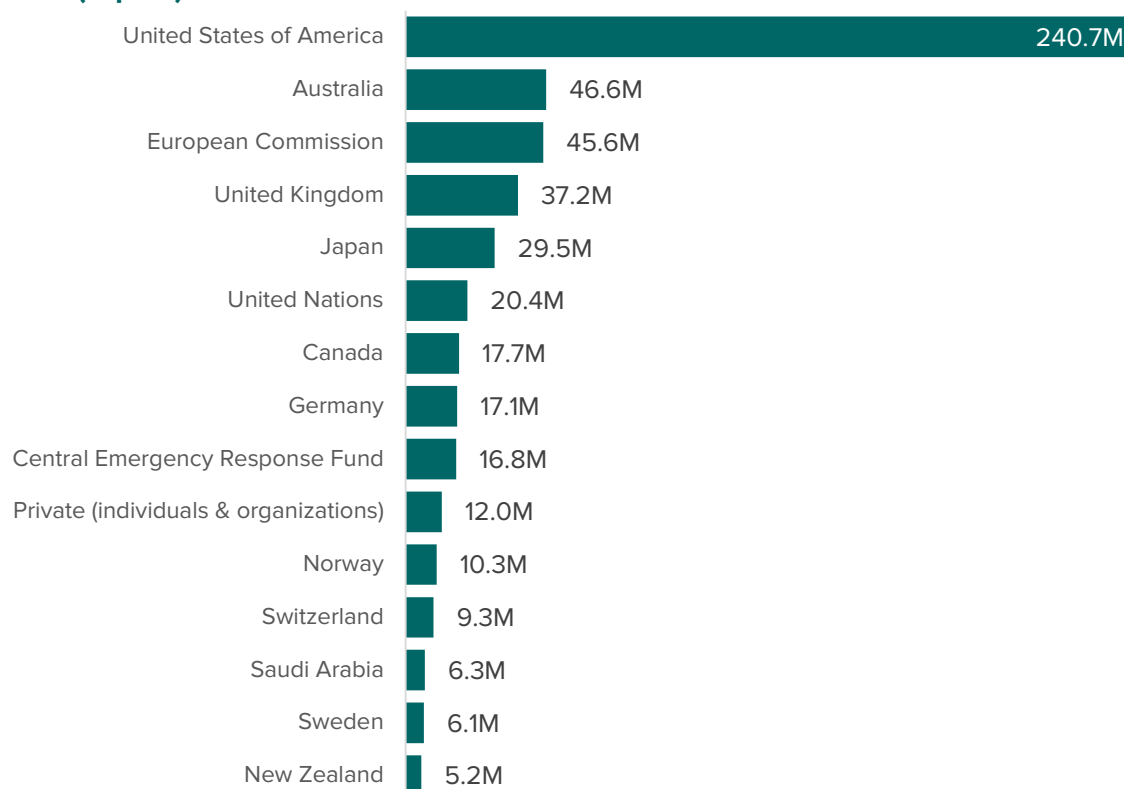

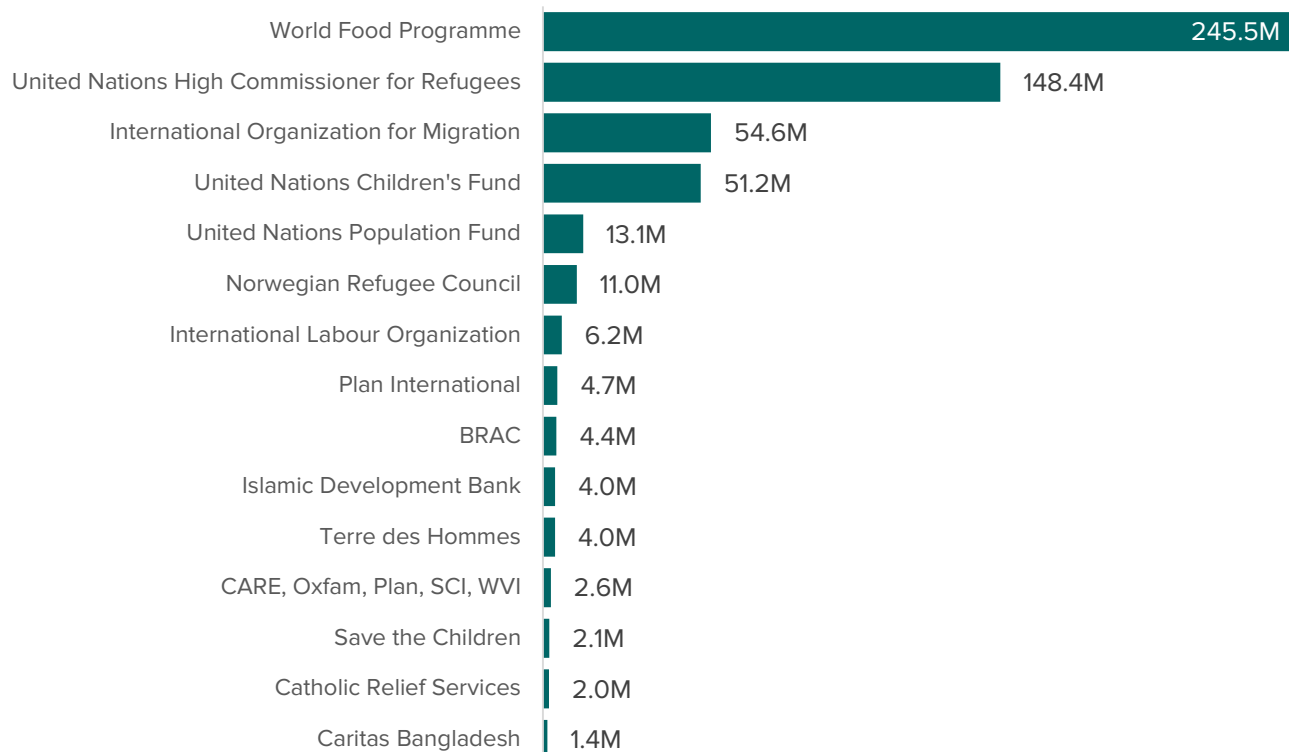
