

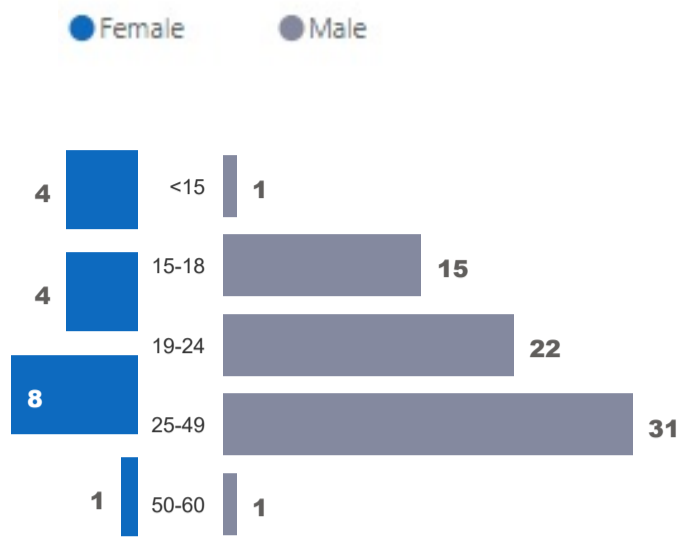

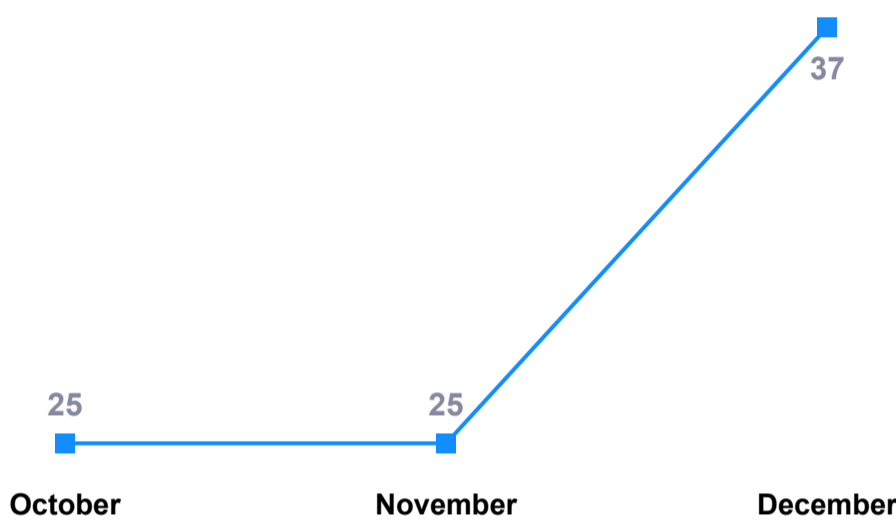

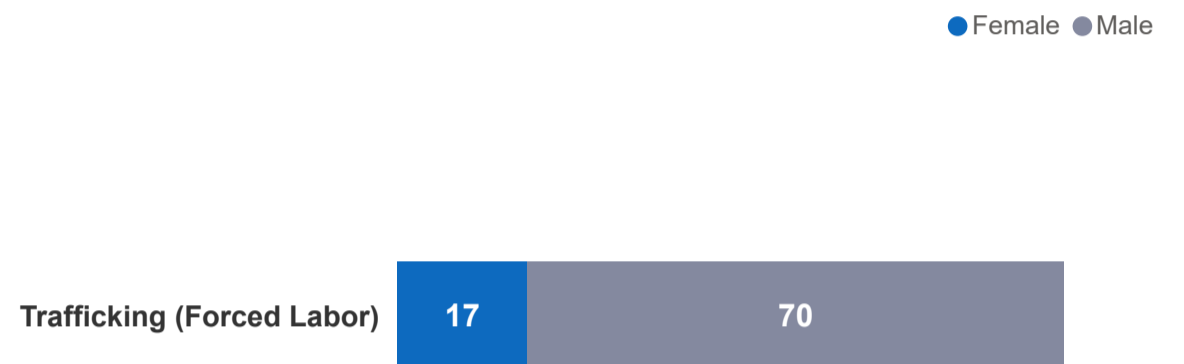

### Number of identified victims by Month

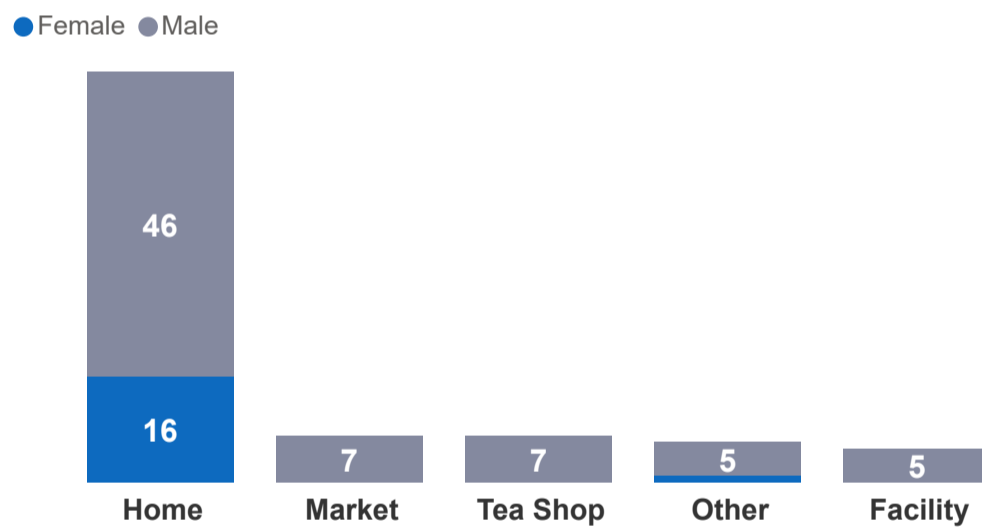


### Type of Trafficking/Form of Exploitation

### Place of Recruitment by Gender

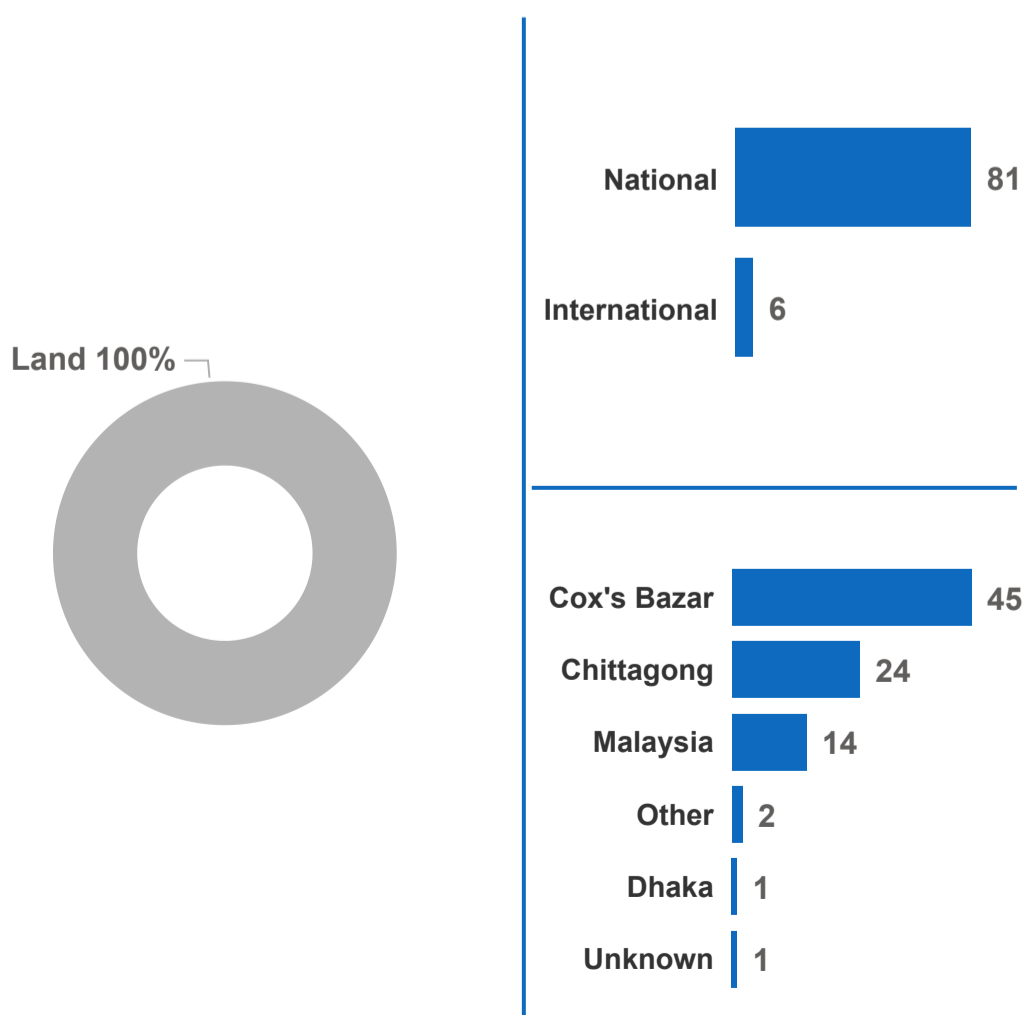


### Promises During Recruitment

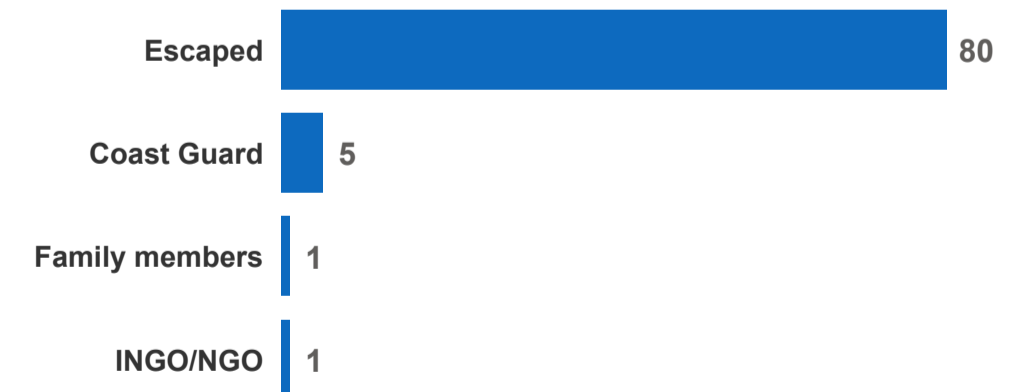
