

The 2024 Joint Response Plan for the Rohingya refugee response is 30 percent funded as of 30 June 2024, with USD 259.3 million received against the overall appeal of USD 852.4 million.

Since the onset of the crisis in August 2017 until 2024, donors have generously contributed nearly USD 4.5 billion to successive JRPs, amounting to 64 percent of the total financial requirements for that period.




