PSEA Network Updates	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • On 29 May, 24 PSEA Focal Points participated in a “Saying No to Sexual Misconduct” Training of Trainers (ToT) session organized by the PSEA Network. • In August 2024, Christian Saunders, the UN Special Coordinator on improving the United Nations response to sexual exploitation and abuse, will visit Bangladesh, including Cox's Bazar. <p>Presentation on ‘Inter-Agency Risk Assessment on SEA (IARA SEA)’</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Gabrielle Sinag Vicente, the National PSEA Officer of IOM Philippines, presented on the IARA SEA (Inter-Agency Risk Assessment on Sexual Exploitation and Abuse) toolkit. She shared the background, process, methodology framework, scope, and the aim of the IARA SEA toolkit. • The IARA SEA (Inter-Agency Risk Assessment on Sexual Exploitation and Abuse) represents a collaborative endeavor aimed at providing a comprehensive overview of risks and response capacities related to Sexual Exploitation and Abuse (SEA) across various contexts, including humanitarian, development, and peacebuilding operations. This initiative involves diverse stakeholders, such as members of the PSEA Network, protection-mandated sectors, working groups, and individual organizations. The term “inter-agency” underscores the collective nature of this effort. 	<p>PSEA Network</p>
<p>Revised SOP and Safe Recruitment</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The revised SOP places greater emphasis on Victim’s Rights, including respect, avoiding harm, maintaining confidentiality, obtaining informed consent, and ensuring non-discrimination. Additionally, the SOP introduces referral pathways: if the alleged perpetrator is a government actor, organizations receiving cases must refer them to the PSEA Network Coordinator. Furthermore, the Network Coordinator will provide support for complex Sexual Exploitation and Abuse (SEA) cases in the field. Notably, UN agencies must share anonymized SEA data with the UN Resident Coordinator (UNRC) Office. • The revised SOP now includes a local background check system for volunteers, enhancing safe recruitment practices within our response efforts. These enhancements will be endorsed alongside the SOP itself, reinforcing our commitment to safeguarding vulnerable populations. <p>✓ The revised Protection from Sexual Exploitation and Abuse (PSEA) Standard Operating Procedure (SoP) was presented during the ROCT meeting on June 2, 2024. Once endorsed, it will be shared.</p>	<p>PSEA Network</p>
