This Trend Analysis dashboard displays data from 2018 to 2024, using different types of data sources for comparing year-to-year trends. If data for a specific year is unavailable, it has not been included in the dashboard. This tool allows for the comparison of the same indicators across different years using data from multiple sources. Since 2021, to maintain consistent data quality, WASH Sector has harmonized its methodology in alignment with various monitoring and assessment initiatives, such as MSNA/ISNA and KAP Surveys etc. By harmonizing these methodologies, the dashboard ensures the accuracy of the insights provided and displaying a comprehensive view of trends and patterns. The dashboard presents all data reported by the different WASH Sector Partners and assessments conducted by third-party monitoring organizations over the past years since 2018.

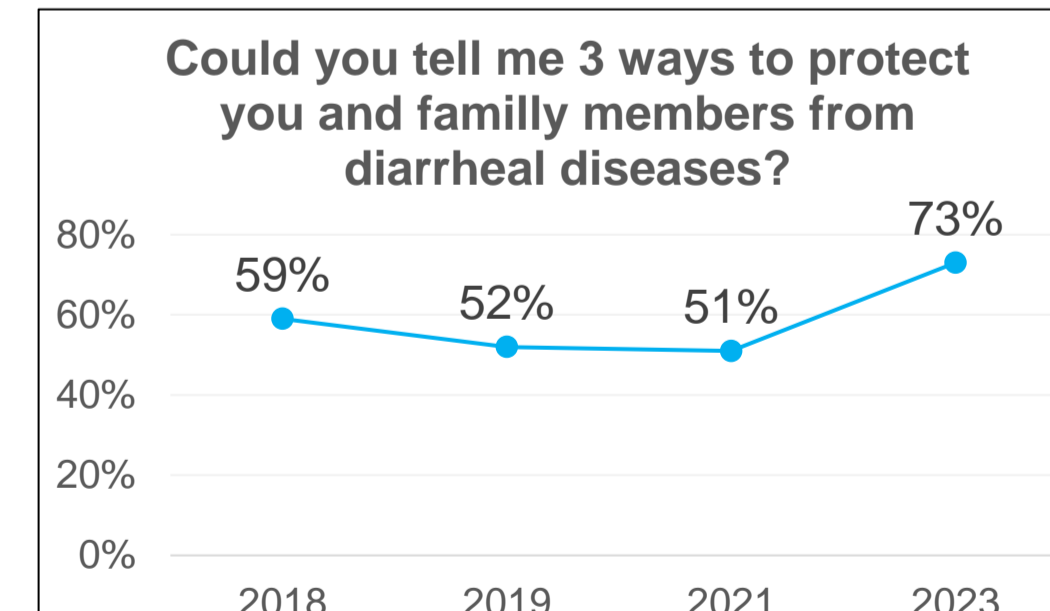
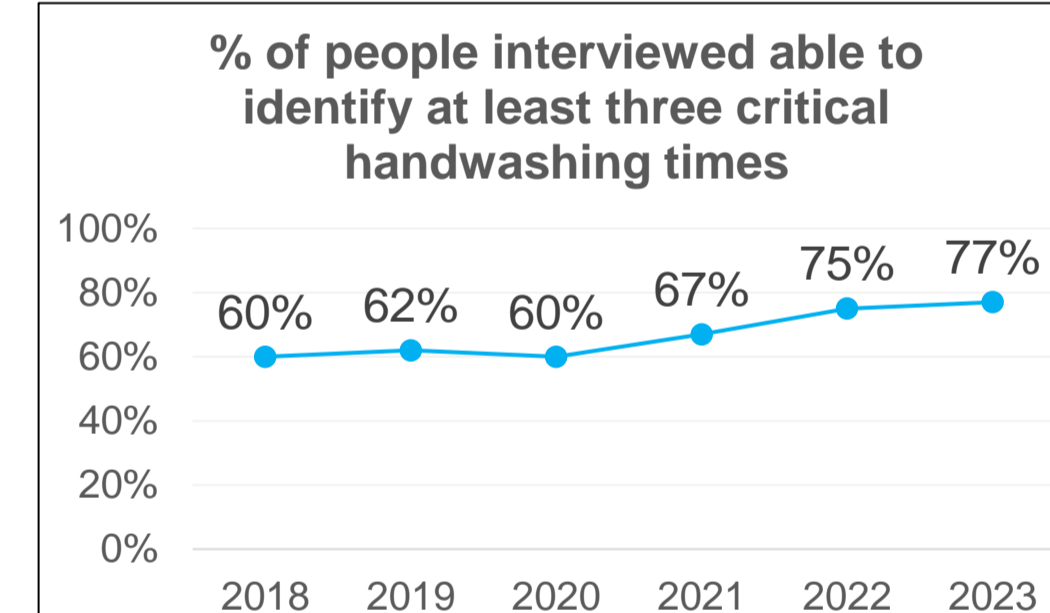
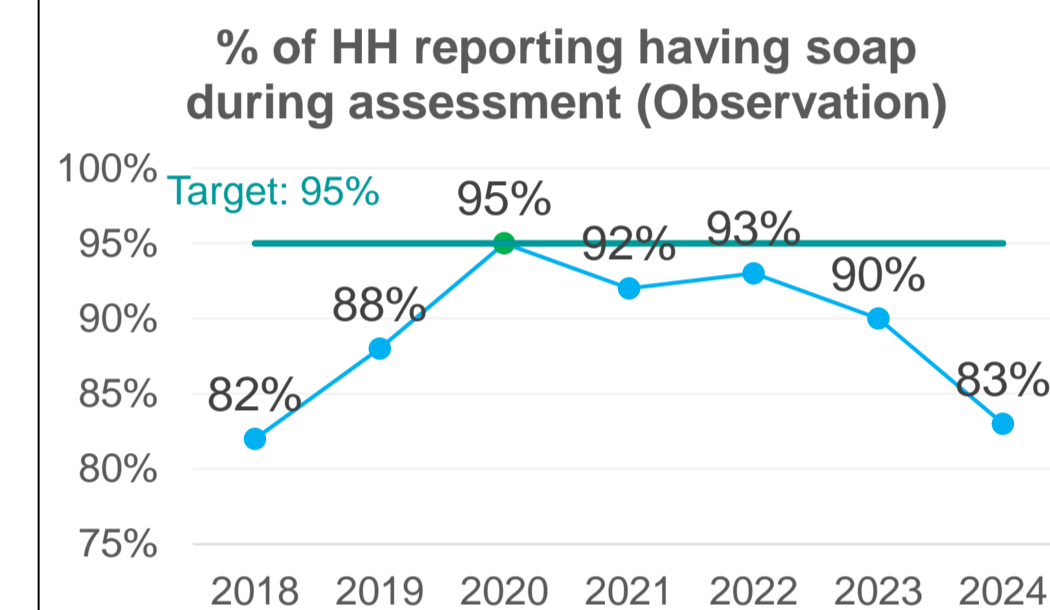
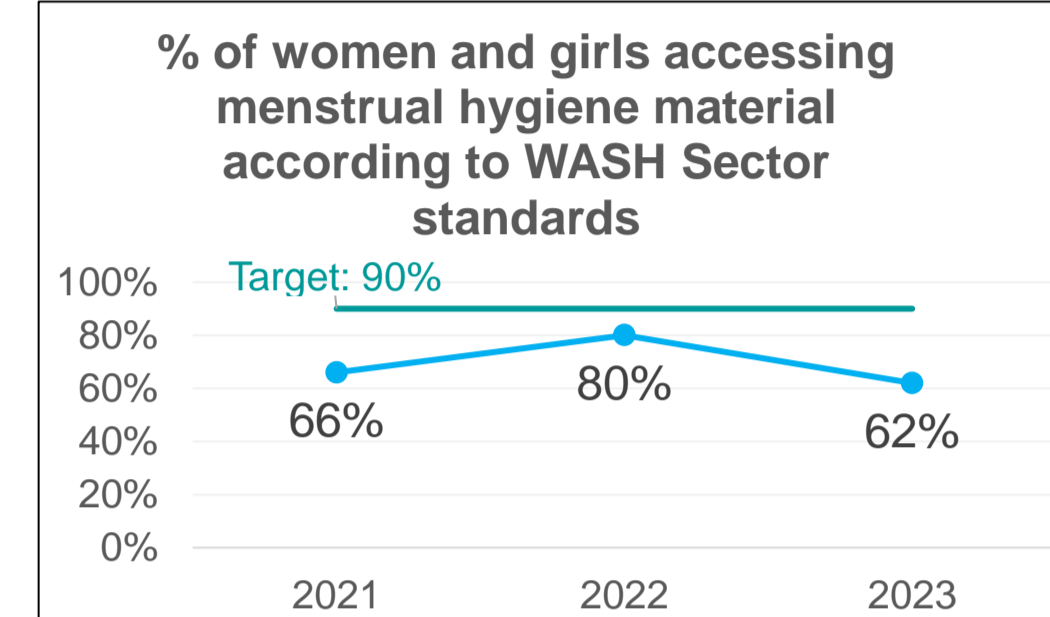
