The 2024 Joint Response Plan for the Rohingya refugee response is 53 percent funded as of 31 October 2024, with USD 452.1 million received against the overall appeal of USD 852.4 million.


Since the onset of the crisis in August 2017 until 2024, donors have generously contributed nearly USD 4.7 billion to successive JRPs, amounting to 68 percent of the total financial requirements for that period.

Note: Approximately USD40M of the funding receive has been allocated to Rohingya Response prior to the launch of the Joint Response Plan 2024.


