

ILO's Definition Green skills are crucial for reducing environmental impact and advancing a green economy.

Key Objectives

Green Skills for Empowerment and Sustainability

- Green Skills Training: Equip refugees and host communities with eco-friendly skills to enhance employability.
- Environmental Protection: Establish practices to minimize waste, reduce pollution, and promote efficient resource use.
- Income Opportunities: Enable income generation through green businesses aligned with local policies.



Green Skills & Business Opportunities

Solar Maintenance & E-Waste Management

- Solar Maintenance Skills: Train refugees to install, maintain, and repair solar systems for camp needs.
- E-Waste Recycling: Develop skills in dismantling, upcycling, and managing e-waste sustainably.
- Pathways for Host Communities: Host communities can create solar energy hubs and establish recycling cooperatives.

Waste Management & Recycling

- Upcycling Projects: Train refugees to repurpose waste into sellable items like bags and mats.
- Recycling Centers: Host communities can establish centers for sorting, composting, and material reuse.
- Youth Engagement: Empower young people as environmental champions for sustainable waste practices.

Bamboo Crafting Create durable products like furniture, baskets, and building materials.




Sustainable Materials Promote eco-friendly and biodegradable alternatives for community use.

Training Module Development Create targeted, culturally relevant training materials.




Monitoring and Evaluation Implement ongoing assessments to ensure effectiveness.
