Welcome and introduction	1. Introductions In her opening remarks, Mehbuba Jabin, the GiHA Coordinator for the ISCG Gender in Humanitarian Action Working Group (GiHA WG), extended a warm welcome to all members.
Previous Meeting Minutes	 <u>Review of Previous Meeting Minutes:</u> September 4, 2024, Gender in Humanitarian Action (GiHA) Working Group meeting happened, and the minutes had been shared with all GiHA WG members for their comments. Final minutes will be uploaded to the GiHA WG website for the GiHA WG members accessibility.
	Action Point: The finalized October minutes will be published on the ISCG website by 30 October 2024.
GiHA WG Membership and WLO/WRO workshop update	2. GiHA WG Membership: This discussion item focused on Revise the GIHA WG Terms of Reference to include standing membership for WLO/WRO's organizations. 2.1. Discuss the outcomes of the GiHA WG WLOs/ WROs workshop held in 29 September 2024.
	Jago Nari Unnayon Sangstha- JNUS, Rohingya Women Walfare Society Bangladesh-RWWS, Bangladesh Nari Progoti Sangha-BNPS, and Breaking The Silence-BTS have been elected through a voting process to represent in the GiHA Working Group.
	Outcome of the workshop:WLOs/WROs have gained a deeper understanding of the GiHA WG structure andIASC principles. An agreement has been established on key principles and theprocess for including WLO/WRO representatives in the GiHA WG.2.2. Key Challenges faced by WLO/WRO organizations:
	 Limited understanding of technical aspects like JRP and GAM reviews. Need for capacity building to contribute effectively to JRP project appeals and GAM code. Lack of focus on gender aspects in JRP and GAM, leading to insufficient representation of women's issues. Lack of awareness of international laws and rights





	3. <u>Gender Transformative Approach/ Gender Sensitive Approach / Gender</u> <u>responsive approach</u> : GiHA WG members discussed the importance of defining and implementing a gender-transformative approach in the next JRP. They emphasized the need to move beyond gender-sensitive or gender-responsive approaches to address underlying structural inequalities.
16 Days DOA	 <u>4.16 Days DOA</u> Formation of a task force with members of the GiHA Working Group to provide support during the 16 Days of Activism Against Gender-Based Violence. Action point: GiHA WG to formulate the task force to support.
Tipsheet	 5.Tipsheets: Five sectors (Child protection Sector, Education Sector, Protection Sector, Livelihood and Skills Sector , Shelter and Site management sector) have already provided their feedback on the tip sheet, and other sectors are encouraged to share their input as well. Action Point: The GiHA WG to receive the final feedback on Gender Tip Sheet with GiHA WG members. 6. Translation: To ensure inclusivity, discussions will be conducted in both English and Bangla. 7. Next Steps and Action Points: TWG on WLO will be established and convening regularly, supporting WLOs, WROs contributions to the GiHA. Gender Data Task Force will be formed under the GiHA Working Group to focus on gender data collection and analysis. A GAM Task Force will be created as part of the Gender with Age Marker (GAM) review process, involving GiHA WG sectoral members.
