<b>GiHA WG WP 2025</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The GiHA work plan for 2025 has been drafted and shared with all GiHA members.</li> <li>• All members are expected to review it and provide feedback for finalizing the documents.</li> <li>• 2024 ongoing GiHA works will be reflected and will continue it's in the 2025 work priority.</li> </ul> <p><b>Action Point: GiHA Work Plan for 2025 will be finalized and shared with the members ASAP.</b></p>

<p><b>Sectoral/ Agency Updates</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The Education sector will conduct one Gender analysis in the upcoming months</li> <li>• CARE, Plan and Oxfam jointly will conduct a GEDSI assessment under a consortium project in the upcoming months.</li> <li>• CARE has conducted Rapid Gender Analysis (RGA) at Bhasanachar supported by JICA in 2023, the final report has been released by JICA and another 5-pager short report has also been developed by CARE.</li> <li>• CARE requested to share the RGA findings and recommendations at the GiHA platform in the next GiHA WG meeting.</li> <li>• GiHA could be supported as a technical review and guidance to analyze the assessment and report as a joint contribution.</li> <li>• The lead organization of the assessments/Gender analysis is invited to be a member of the Gender Analysis Taskforce Team under GiHA</li> <li>• UNFPA conducted one service mapping and identified the WLO and WRO agencies that are specifically working on GBV and SRH components in the Coxs bazaar and they asked to share the report with GiHA WG on the findings.</li> </ul>
<p><b>GAM review by PRT – JRP 2025</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The JRP 2025 GAM report has been reviewed by all sectoral Gender focal and the GAM analysis reporting template has been asked to be shared with the GiHA Coordinator</li> <li>• Gender Final Tip sheet will be shared by GiHA by January 2025 onwards, GBVSS Gender focal requested a separate GBV Tip sheet for GBVSS partners</li> </ul>
<p><b>WLO/WRO agency workshop update</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 2<sup>nd</sup> Workshop will be facilitated by the GIHA working group to strengthen the selected 4 WLO/WRO agencies and build their capacity on representation skills at the GIHA platform.</li> </ul>
