2. Management of under 6 months infants: tools and SOP finalization

SoP and rapid assessment tool have been developed considering the discussion came from the Workshop organized in December 2024. CMAM TWG members together reviewed the SoP and rapid assessment tool together and made some changes to contextualize the modality. It would be shared with Nutrition Sector Coordinator for endorsement.

3. Update from all partners on piloting WHO recommendations – total admission vs discharge, any key challenge

All SAM children under the piloting were discharged. Implementing partners will share the case and control database with UNICEF & WFP TWG members. GK did not receive the piloting database from World Vision. World Vision was piloting the MAM per-kg body weight ration recommendation. GK and CMAM TWG will explore possible way including communicating with World Vision for the database.

4. Analysis of the trends and possible reasons of high LOS and poor AWG

Due to shortage of time, the discussion on high LOS and poor AWG is very short. All implementing partners were requested to summarize the possible reasons from their analysis of the programmatic data. This will be compiled and documented from the CMAM TWG.

5. CMAM TWG meeting schedule for 2025

CMAM TWG members discussed to set the meeting schedule for the whole year of 2025. Initially, members decided to schedule the meeting on Wednesday of the 3rd week of each month starting from March 2025.
