US Funding issues and Challenges in camp	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Camp 11 focal, Mr. Javed, shared that all activities by "Protyashi" have been suspended in the camp as well as in other camps where they operated. • DRC representative, Mr. Ranjan, mentioned that DRC does not rely on US funding. They plan to extend their implementation to three additional camps as per the 2025 JRP, with execution starting in March. DRC, Mr. Ranjan, shared that they have no US funds, and they will extend their implementation to more 3 camps as per 2025 JRP by March
Sharing the information and strengthening of Communication	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mr. Javed raised concerns about the need for an orientation program to guide Camp focals on developing communication with CiCs, stakeholders, and sector representatives. • Some interchanges of camp focals are happening in camps. NRC colleagues shared that recent changes in responsibilities within the organization have affected camp focal areas. They were suggested to share the information by mail by mail as soon as possible. • The sector advised camp focals to maintain regular communication with the sector teams and share meeting minutes and updates on any new interventions in the camps by different partners. Additionally, focal points should inform sector colleagues about coordination meetings if there any urgent discussion sector could be joined as well.
