Contextualize SoP for IYCF-E  All members agreed to develop a context-specific Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for Infant and Young Child Feeding in Emergencies (IYCF-E) interventions, based on the national IYCF guidelines and a review of previous documents. The Technical Working Group (TWG) will focus on reviewing and developing SOPs for the following seven thematic areas:  1. SOP for IYCF-E Programming 2. SOP for Cooking Demonstrations 3. SOP for Health Education Sessions 4. SOP for Mother-to-Mother Support Groups (MTMSG) 5. SOP for Adolescent Sessions 6. SOP for Non-Breastfed Infant (NBF) Management 7. SOP for Father Support Groups  The IYCF TWG will share a link or folder containing all relevant documents for input and contribution toward finalizing the SOPs.
