<b>CXB PSEAH Network Updates</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Key Highlights from 2025: <a href="#">Link</a></li> <li>• In December 2025, the Training of Trainers (ToT) on PSEA for Rohingya community volunteers was completed, reaching 1,300 volunteers across 33 camps.</li> <li>• IOM and WFP conducted community awareness activities through <i>Forum Theatre</i> in 10 camps, in coordination with the PSEA Network. The initiative began on 25 November and continued until 15 December 2025.</li> <li>• The Cox's Bazar PSEA Network, in collaboration with the Bangladesh Network, finalized the 2026 PSEA Action Plan with active member input. As recommended by the UNRC, this integrated plan will be implemented nationwide, including the Rohingya response. It will be shared with the members once endorsed.</li> <li>• The revised PSEA SOP for SEA complaint referral was circulated to Network members, the GBV Sub-Sector/cluster Coordinators for feedback. The final endorsed SOP will be shared in January 2026.</li> <li>• The draft Safe Recruitment Checklist for Volunteers and PSEA Key Messages for Adolescents were shared with members for review and feedback, with a deadline of 6 January. The finalized versions will be circulated soon.</li> </ul>	<b>PSEAH Network</b>

<p><b>PSEAH Focal Points Assessment Survey</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The PSEAH Focal Points Assessment Survey is currently ongoing. The survey, which was launched on 4 December 2025, will remain open until 15 January 2026. This assessment is being conducted by the CXB PSEAH Network to verify active and engaged focal points, update contact information, and identify capacity-building and training needs for the 2026 Workplan.</li> <li>Members who will not participate in the survey within the specified timeframe will have their membership put on hold pending review.</li> </ul>	<p><b>PSEAH Network Members</b></p>
<p><b>Volunteer PSEA Training</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The Cox's Bazar PSEA Network advanced its community-based PSEA capacity-building initiative by training Rohingya community volunteers across all 33 camps to strengthen prevention, safe reporting, and consistent victim-centered practices at the community level. Coordination was carried out with all 10 sectors, the RRRC office, Site Management, and camp-level focal points, with sectors providing volunteer lists. Between 23 November and 18 December 2025, the Network conducted 66 Training-of-Trainers (ToT) sessions across all 33 camps, resulting in 1,300 volunteers trained (32% female, 68% male).</li> <li>The next phase aims to ensure that 100% of sector volunteers receive the mandatory PSEA training by April 2026, through sector-led coordination and by utilizing the trained volunteer resource pool established during Phase one.</li> </ul> <p>The Network requested all member organizations to notify their programme teams to coordinate at field level with the respective sectors to ensure full participation of volunteers in the upcoming trainings.</p>	<p><b>PSEAH Network Members</b></p>
<p><b>Q1 Priorities (January 2026 to March 2026)</b></p>	<p>The Network will prioritize the following activities during Quarter 1 (January–March 2026):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Roll out the Standard Operating Procedure for SEA Complaint Referral in Bangladesh</li> <li>Update the current PSEAH Network member list to ensure accurate representation across agencies.</li> <li>Share the updated PSEAH Focal Point Terms of Reference (ToR) with all member organizations.</li> <li>Conduct PSEA training for volunteers, in coordination with relevant sectors and utilizing the Phase 1 trained resource pool.</li> <li>Develop an Information-Sharing Protocol with the RRRC to strengthen inter-agency coordination on SEAH-related information.</li> </ul>	<p><b>PSEAH Network Members</b></p>
<p><b>AoB (Any other business)</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>NGO Champions:</b> The meeting emphasized the need to develop clear and detailed Terms of Reference (ToR) for NGO Champions to define their roles and responsibilities.</li> </ul> <p>Welthungerhilfe Bangladesh highlighted that NGO Champions should provide support to organizations facing resource or capacity gaps.</p> <p>WFP noted that many local and national NGOs still lack full institutional capacity and encouraged NGO Champions to take proactive steps to strengthen these organizations, enhancing their readiness for future</p>	<p><b>PSEAH Network Members</b></p>

partnerships with UN agencies. WFP also expressed willingness to support NGO Champions with orientation and training for the initiative.

- The Network will draft a ToR for the NGO Champions and share it with members for review and feedback. Priority activities for the NGO Champions will be finalized in consultation with the Champions and subsequently shared with Network members.
